SEWING VACUUM



NOTE: This Class Is Designed for the IQ Designer on the Babylock Embroidery Machine

Supplies:

- 1 – Babylock Plastic Bag or Candy Bag**
- 1/3 to 1/2 yd of fabric for lining**
- 1 – 14” to 16” Zipper (color or your choice)**
- No Show mesh to fit largest hoop**
- Babylock Ultra Soft Stabilizer**
- Embroidery Thread of your choice**
- Pellon Vinyl Fuse or other Vinyl**

Other Supplies:

- Embroidery Machine along with your largest hoop**
- Sewing ankle for converting machine into sewing**
- Narrow zipper foot**
- 1/4” foot**
- J foot**
- Coordinating thread**
- 6”x24” Quilters Select Ruler**
- 28mm Rotary Cutter or 45mm Rotary Cutter with new blade**
- 90/14 Embroidery Needle (new)**
- Sharp scissors and regular sewing supplies**

- 1 Using a small babylock bag, cookie or candy bag you need to very carefully cut the bag on the bottom and sides.**
- 2 Hoop 1 layer of No Show Mesh and 1 layer of Babylock Ultra Soft Fusible Stabilizer in your largest hoop.**
- 3 Place your bag and a layer of the vinyl onto your hoop and put onto the machine centering on the hoop.**
- 4 Select the Fill Stitch of your choice on your IQ machine and take the design into embroidery.**
- 5 Note: Most likely you will need to tape your bag down to keep the embroidery foot from catching on the bag unless your bag is much larger than the embroidery area.**
- 6 After embroidery is complete on both sides of bag pieces, square your pieces.**
- 7 To put zipper in measure in $\frac{3}{4}$ " from stitching line on each side on the top of your bag.**
- 8 Cut (2) pieces of your lining to the same size as your bag side pieces.**
- 9 Cut (1) piece of your lining fabric 2" x 4". Press wrong sides together along the long side and then press raw edges into the center.**
- 10 Cut this piece into (2) $\frac{3}{4}$ " pieces.**
- 11 Without opening your zipper, cut off the bottom end of your zipper and stitch on your $\frac{3}{4}$ " pieces onto the bottom of the zipper.**
- 12 Lay zipper onto top edge of bag and mark on your zipper at the $\frac{3}{4}$ " of your bag.**
- 13 Carefully open your zipper and cut the zipper off above the $\frac{3}{4}$ " mark.**
- 14 Stitch the remaining piece onto this end of the zipper.**
- 15 Press the Stitch Perfection Tape onto each side of the zipper and then place onto top of bag.**
- 16 Lay the lining face down on the wrong side of the zipper and stitch zipper in place using your zipper foot.**
- 17 Top stitch bag, zipper and lining and repeat for the other side.**
- 18 Square up your bag.**
- 19 Open your zipper at this point.**
- 20 Lay your bag with right sides together (bag to bag and lining to lining.)**
- 21 Stitch across the bottom of the bag and then down each side to the bottom of the lining.**
- 22 Stitch the bottom of the lining leaving an opening for turning.**
- 23 Box the corners on the bag and lining.**
- 24 Turn your bag through the opening and you are finished.**
