

KIDS KAMP 2020



FABRIC SEWING TRAY JULY 16, 2020 2pm

SUPPLIES:

Two 12" x 12" pieces of cotton fabric
One 12" x 12" Single Sided Fusible Batting
Spool of construction thread
48" of ¼" wide ribbon
Standard presser foot
Point turner
Frixion marking pen
Ruler

¼" Applique Wonder Tape or ¼" Steam a Seam

Basic sewing supplies: scissors, ruler, wonder clips, pins, seam ripper, ect. INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Cut ribbon into eight 6" pieces.
- 2. Place the fusible batting on the ironing board with fusible side facing up. Place front $12" \times 12"$ fabric wrong side down of batting. Fuse with iron.
- 3. Measure and mark 3" on both sides of all four corners on the right side of the fabric square for a total of eight markings.
- 4. Place the square on a work surface right side facing up. With the raw edges even, and the ribbon tails laying on the square, pin or clip the ribbon on the markings. Sew in place.
- 5. With the right side facing up, lay this piece on the work surface. Make sure all the ribbon tails point toward the center of the square.
- 6. Place the second piece of fabric on top, right sides together.
- 7. Pin all the layers together.
- 8. Using the edge of the foot as a guide, sew around all four sides. Leave about a 2" opening for turning.
- 9. Turn right side out. Use the point turner to make nice corners. Press.
- 10. Sew the opening by hand or use a ¼" fusible and press closed.
- 11. Lay out on a flat surface. With the Frixion Pen, draw a square in the center, leaving a 2" border all the way around. Sew along the drawn lines. Press to remove the pen.
- 12. Tie two ribbons into a bow at each corner.
