Mini Accent Shamrock Table Runner

March 4, 2020 -10:00-4:00

This project is pieced and appliqued and requires accurate $\frac{1}{2}$ " seams. Pattern is required but it is a great way to utilize your scraps/stash. Pattern shows 2 shamrocks finished with light colors and one finished with dark prints. Background blocks are also alternating light and dark fabrics. Finished size is 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 29 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Class Supply List:

Pattern: Patchwork Accent Runner Shamrocks (Shabby Fabrics) available for purchase at Above & Beyond

Required materials as listed on pattern:

Scraps of 10 various light green fabrics for patchwork

Scraps of 10 various dark green fabrics for patchwork

3 10"x10" squares for background, light and/or dark depending upon your choice

Scrap of white for sashing (1" by WOF)

1/3 yard black for sashing and binding (1" WOF for sashing, (3) 2 ½" WOF for binding)

1/3 yard for backing

Fusible webbing to attach patchwork applique

2 yards Quilters Select Cutaway for grid construction (Optional technique demonstrated in class)

Batting, 12" x 36"

General Sewing Supplies

Rotary Cutter, ruler (nonslip QS recommended for very small strips), scissors, pins, clips, seam ripper (GO! Big Electric Cutter & $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " die will be available for strips/squares)

Thread for piecing blocks , applique and quilting

Sewing machine in good working order with power cord, foot pedal (if desired), ¼" foot, open toe foot or applique foot of your choice.

Personal(mini) iron and pressing mat recommended.
