

Jelly Roll Christmas Gift Bag



- Straps (2) strips
- Bag Body (5) strips
- Lining 10.5 x 21"

- Cut your jelly rolls strips in half (you will only use half of each strip)
- Stitch your strips together in a pleasing order



- Place lining and strip set right sides together and stitch each short ends. Press seams to strip set.



- Now refold so that the lining is next to the lining and the strip set is next to the strip set. Pin seam allowances so they align and are pressed towards the strip set.



- Cut a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square of all four corners, two from the lining and two from the strip set.
- Mark as follows: 1" from bottom of seam allowance on the strip set side and a second mark 1" below the first marking. Mark on both edges.
- Stitch across both long edges leave opening in the lining to turn and leave two openings for the casing.
- Square all four corners



- Turn right sides out and press.
- Stitch opening in lining.
- Top stitch around the top edge close to the fold.
- Mark with frixion pen both of your casing stitch lines. You will locate the opening the mark and align with the opening on the other side seam.
- Make your ties, using two jelly roll strips. I cut mine to about 35" in length. Fold sides together lengthwise, fold raw edge to center fold and refold along original fold line. Top stitch both long edges on the ties.
- Insert ties into casings.
