

Mystery \#41
Sewing Part 2
*referring to our units we made in the previous sewing part 1 are (unit As)
Step 1; sew four Unit As together in the fallowing fabric order to create column 1;
G (It. blue small flower), E (red grunge), E (red grunge), J (blue flowers)
*be sure to refer to the picture below to make sure your blocks are facing the right direction. *repeat this step to make a total of 3 columns. Press.


Step 2; sew four Unit As together in the fallowing order to create column 2;
F (navy plaid), K (navy thatched), K (navy thatched), D (It. blue flags)
*be sure to refer to the picture below to make sure your blocks are facing the right direction. *repeat this step to make a total of 3 columns. Press.


Step 3; sew six Unit As together in the fallowing order to create column 3;
G (It. blue small flowers), G (It. blue small fowers), C (navy star), C (navy star), F (navy plaid), F (navy plaid)
*be sure to refer to the picture below to make sure your blocks are facing the right direction.
*repeat this step to make a total of 3 columns. Press.


Step 4; sew six Unit As together in the fallowing order to create column 4; J (blue flowers), J (blue flowers), B (red star), B (red star), D (It. blue flags), D (It. blue flags) *be sure to refer to the picture below to make sure your blocks are facing the right direction.
*repeat this step to make a total of 3 columns. Press.


Step 5; from fabric H (white w/ mini color star) you should have a few left over strips of fabric that should measure $1.5 \times W O F$. We are going to subcut them into (6) $1.5 \times 6.5$ and (6) $1.5 \times 8.5$
Step 6; Take fabric A (white on white) (3) 6.5 squares and your fabric $H$ strips place one 6.5 pieces on left \& right side of block. Sew RST. Press. Then take two 8.5 pieces top \& bottom of block. Sew RST. Press.
*Your block should now measure $8.5 \times 8.5$. repeat for a total of 3 total blocks.


Step 7; Now were going to sew the columns onto the center blocks we just created.
*Lay out your block with column A on the left side of the block.
*Column B on the right side of the block
*Column C on the top of the block
Column D on the bottom of the block
*refer to the pictures below to make sure you all blocks are facing the right direction and matching the right fabrics!
*repeat to complete 3 total blocks. They should measure $12.5 \times 12.5$
