

Machine Binding Workshop

Piecing thread, Small scissors, Rotary cutter, Cutting Mat, Ruler, ¼ inch foot (required), Foot with a center flange (i.e. stitch-in-the-ditch, or narrow edge), Glue stick, Sewing machine (and manual) in good working order

4 fat quarters , 1/2 yard for light colored fabric for binding, 1/2 yard of thin batting, pins or spray for basting, paper and pens for notes

Before class, using the above fat quarters and batting, baste two sandwiches for working with in class. These will be made into samples for you to refer to later. Please don't use a previously unfinished project.
