

Mystery \#41-Final 05/19/2023

Step 1; Block Row; Arrange and sew three center blocks and four 2"x12.5" (fabric I) rectangles into a row. RST. Press seams as you go!


Step 2; Inner border; Sew 2"×42.5" (fabric I) strips to top and bottom of the runner.
Step 3; Outer Border (sides) Arrange and sew your two five square side borders to the left and right of runner. I switched mine on either side, so they were opposite. Press.
Step 4; Outer Border (top/bottom) Arrange and sew together your two sixteen square borders to the top and bottom of runner. Make sure your end square seams are matching on all four corners. Press.


Finishing; Place backing fabric right side down, batting, and top right side up. Baste these layers together and quilt as desired. Once you're done quilting trim all three layers to be even with the runner top.

Prepare your binding (fabric M) either (4) $21 / 4 " \times$ WOF or $21 / 2$ " WOF. Sew strips together end to end using 45 degree seems to make a continuous strip. Fold strip in half lengthwise (wrong sides together) and press. Bind as desired.

Finishing your runner is up to you and your creativity. I used the Kimberbell Clear Blue Tiles in the blank white center squares. *Refer to Facebook live video for 05/19/2023
But there are so many options that you can do for putting in those squares and for quilting this table runner!
