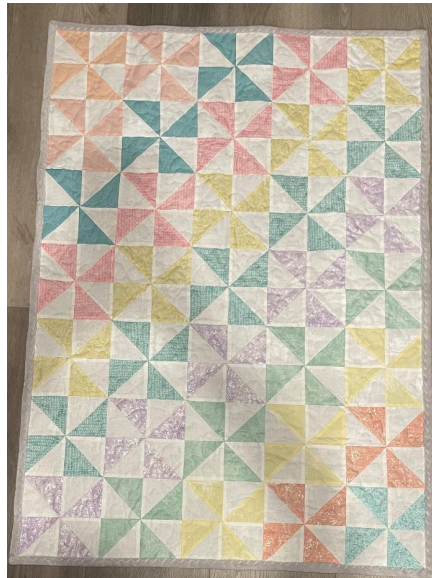


Riley's Pinwheels Quilt

Finished size 31" x 44"



1/8 yard of 11 different fabrics - 4" x 4" squares

1 yard of background fabric - (70) 4" x 4" squares

1 yard of minky fabric - backing and binding

- Mark a diagonal line on each background fabric square
- Place RST one background and one colored square and stitch on either side of the marked line at $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Cut on drawn line and press seam allowance to the colored fabric. Square to a $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Repeat. You will need 4 small blocks to create one pin wheel.
- Now stitch the blocks together to create a pin wheel.
- Repeat making pin wheel blocks in this manner using the above photo as a layout and color guide. You can choose to create this as a diagonal pattern or an all over random pattern.
- Stitch together with 5 blocks across and 7 blocks down.
- Back using the minky fabric, quilt as desired. (I quilted using the edge to edge function in the Solaris). Trim down backing with a 1" overlap and create a self binding using a double fold and miter at the corners. Machine stitch using a serpentine stitch.
