Featured Foot: Pintuck



CLASS LESSON:

1. Quilting with a guide attachment.
2. Twin needles/two threads.
3. PINTUCK foot.
4. Reverse applique.



PREQUILT BACKGROUNDS:

1. Mark the 14" square background block with an air soluble marker a straight line 1" from left hand side edge
2. Insert a 4.0 twin needle in the machine with two colors of thread. Straight stitch on the 1" line.
3. Place the guide attachment on the machine, measure over to right 1". Place guide on the line, continue stitching vertical lines.
4. Trim block to 12½".

PINTUCK FABRIC:

1. Cut a 6" square of fabric.
2. Insert a 2.0 needle.
Place the PINTUCK foot on the machine. This technique does not include cording in the tucks.
3. Make the first tuck on the diagonal on the machine.

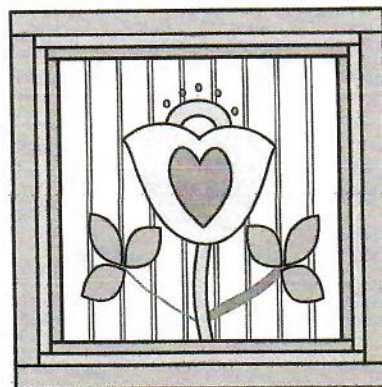


Use the far left groove as a guide for the remaining tucks (approximately ¼" apart).
Stitch. Continue across the 6" square.

4. Press from the wrong side of the fabric.

Above & Beyond

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APPLIQUE:

1. Prepare the large tulip (#6) from fusible web.
2. Cut out the heart opening.
3. Fuse to fabric.
4. Cut out piece #6 and the opening.
5. Use the opening as a guide to trim the pintucked fabric 3/8" LARGER than the opening.
6. Lay out all the applique pieces on the background.
7. Insert the pintuck fabric BEHIND the opening in piece #6. Fuse the pieces in place.

SUGGESTION FOR APPLIQUE:

change width and length

Center #4: + + +
Center #5: _ _ _
Flower: * * *
Inside flower: + + +
Stems: _ _ _
Leaves: < < <

BORDERS:

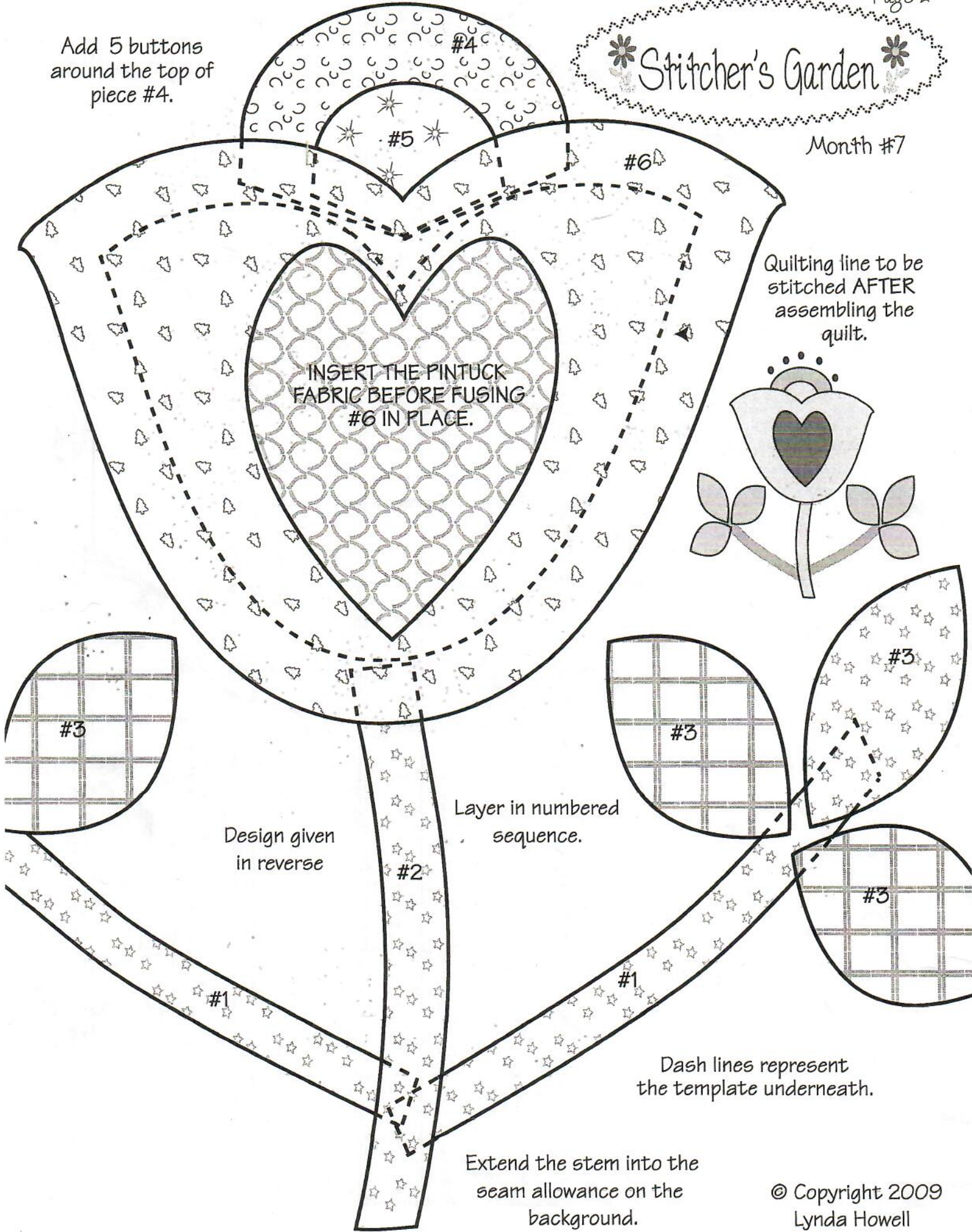
- Color #1 - cut 2 - 1" x 12½" and 2 - 1" x 13½"
Color #2 - cut 2 - 1" x 13½" and 2 - 1" x 14½"
Color #3 - cut 2 - 1½" x 14½" and 2 - 1½" x 16½"
Sew all borders to the block.

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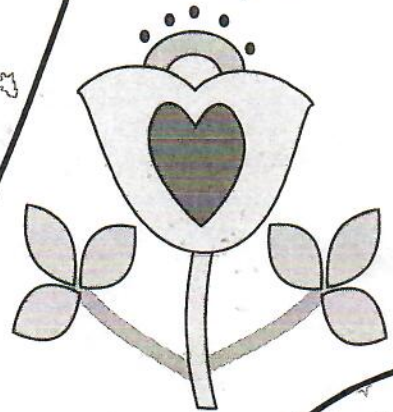
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Add 5 buttons around the top of piece #4.



INSERT THE PINTUCK FABRIC BEFORE FUSING #6 IN PLACE.

Quilting line to be stitched AFTER assembling the quilt.
