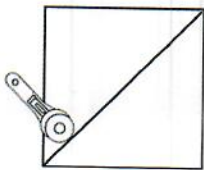
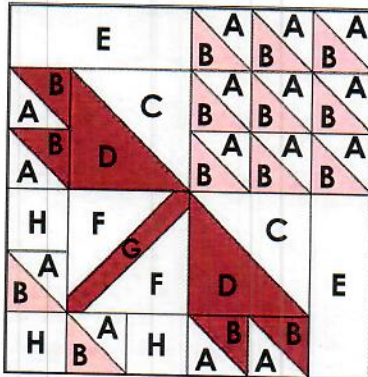


**PLEASE NOTE:** B triangles are shown using (2) fabrics. Adjust cutting according to quantity of fabrics you wish to use.

## Cutting

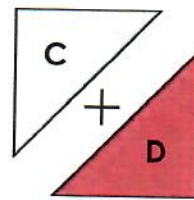


Cut Square Once Diagonally

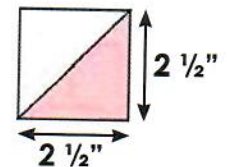
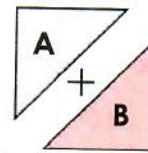
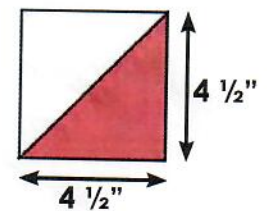
<b>A</b>	(8) 2 7/8" squares; cut each square once diagonally to make (16) A triangles. Please note: (1) triangle will be unused. <i>Grunge #30150 101</i>
<b>B</b>	(8) 2 7/8" squares; cut each square once diagonally to make (16) B triangles. (1) triangle will be unused. <i>Grunge-6 from 325 &amp; 2 from 365</i>
<b>C</b>	(1) 4 7/8" square; cut the square once diagonally to make (2) C triangles. <i>Grunge #30150 101</i>
<b>D</b>	(1) 4 7/8" square; cut the square once diagonally to make (2) D triangles. <i>Grunge #30150 365</i>
<b>E</b>	Cut (2) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles. <i>Grunge #30150 101</i>
<b>F</b>	(1) 4 1/2" square; cut once diagonally to make (2) F triangles. <i>Grunge #30150 101</i>
<b>G</b>	(1) 1" x 6 1/2" rectangle. <i>Grunge #30150 365</i>
<b>H</b>	(3) 2 1/2" squares. <i>Grunge #30150 101</i>

## Assembly

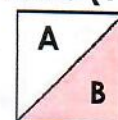
- Both small and large HST units are needed to create this block. Begin large HST unit assembly by placing (1) C triangle and (1) D triangle right sides together and edges aligned.
- Sew along the longest edge using a 1/4" seam.
- Trim HST unit to measure 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" unfinished. Press toward the dark fabric.
- Repeat to create (2) identical large HST units.
- Begin small HST unit assembly using the same techniques described above and (15) A and B triangles. (Please note: Diagrams and quilt block is shown using (2) small HST unit colorways.)
- Trim small HST units to measure 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" unfinished.



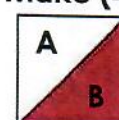

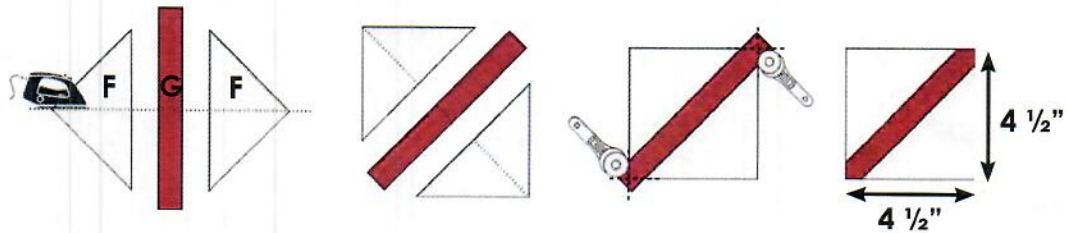

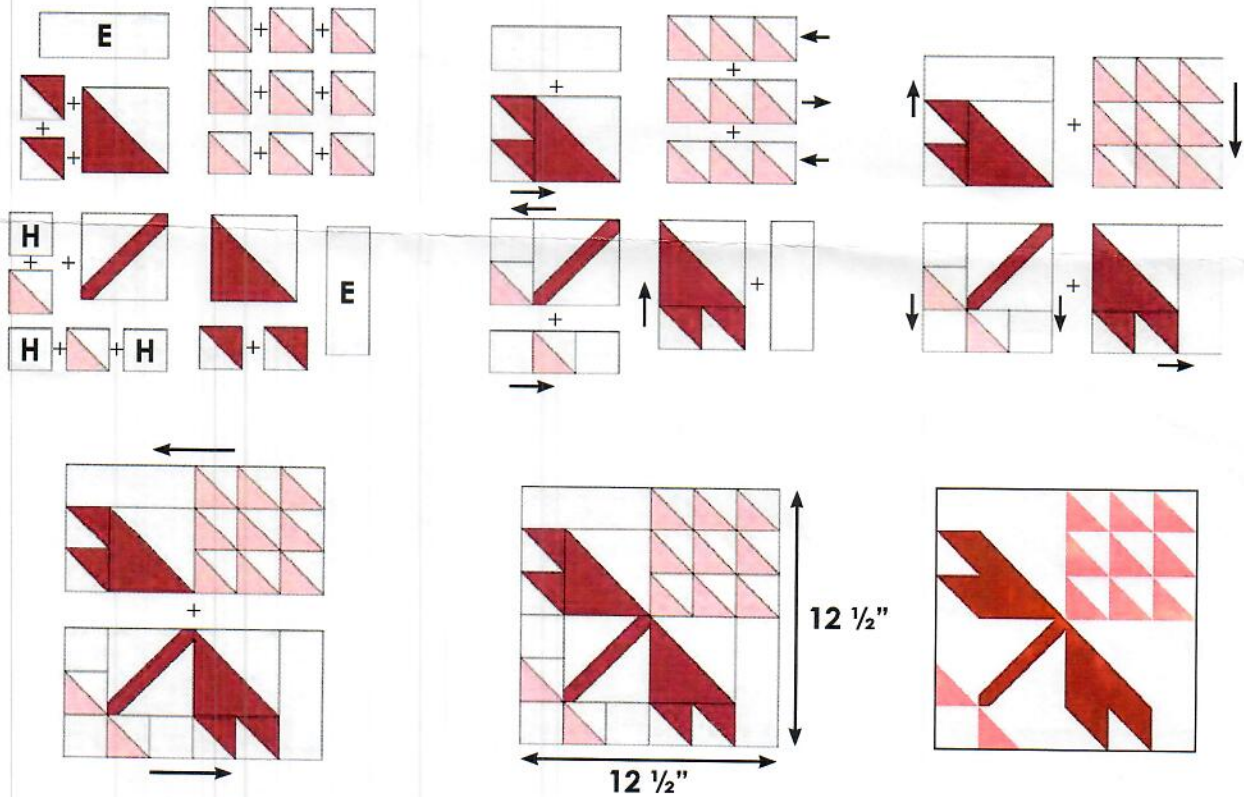


Block 4  
Flower Power

7. Create the block stem using (1) G rectangle and (2) F triangles. Begin by pressing the F triangles and the G rectangle in half to mark the exact centers with a crease.
8. Line up the creased centers and sew (1) F triangle onto either side of the G rectangle.
9. Press triangles away from the G rectangle.
10. Remove excess fabric, trimming the stem to measure  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.



11. Lay out all units created in the above steps, (2) E rectangles and (3) H squares as shown. Sew the block together in quadrants. Arrows indicate pressing instructions.
12. Sew the quadrants together to complete the block. Press to complete. Block should measure  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.

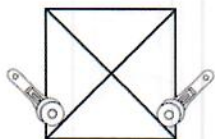
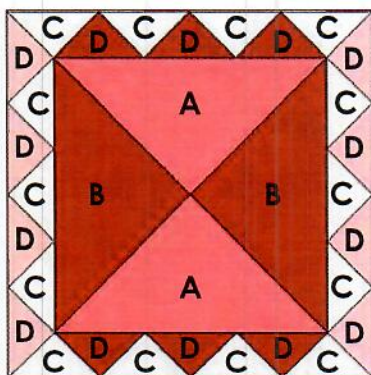

## Cutting



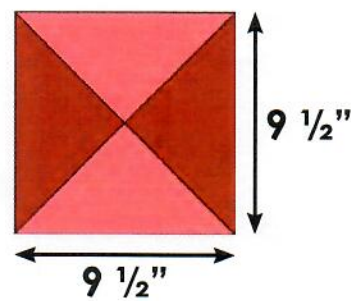
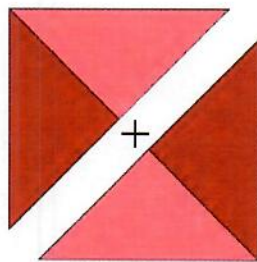
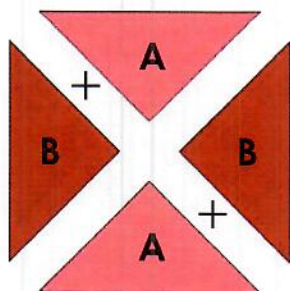
Cut Square Twice Diagonally

**PLEASE NOTE:** The block diagrams are shown using (2) fabrics for the "D" units. Plan cutting and fabric placement before proceeding. Use a scant  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam when piecing this block.

<b>A</b>	(1) $10\frac{1}{4}$ " square; cut the square twice diagonally to make (4) A triangles. Please note that (2) triangles will be unused. <i>Grunge 30150-325</i>
<b>B</b>	(1) $10\frac{1}{4}$ " square; cut the square twice diagonally to make (4) B triangles. Please note that (2) triangles will be unused. <i>Grunge 30150-254</i>
<b>C</b>	(4) $4\frac{1}{4}$ " squares; cut each square twice diagonally to make (16) C triangles. Please note that (2) triangles will be unused. <i>Grunge 30150-101</i>
<b>D</b>	(4) $4\frac{1}{4}$ " squares; cut each square twice diagonally to make (16) D triangles. Please note that (2) triangles will be unused. <i>Grunge - 2 each from 30150-325 &amp; 30150-254.</i>

## Assembly

1. Make a QST unit for the center of the block using (2) A triangles and (2) B triangles. The longest edges of the triangles will create the outside edges of the QST unit.
2. Sew together as shown, pressing seams to the B triangles. Once complete, trim the QST unit to measure  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.



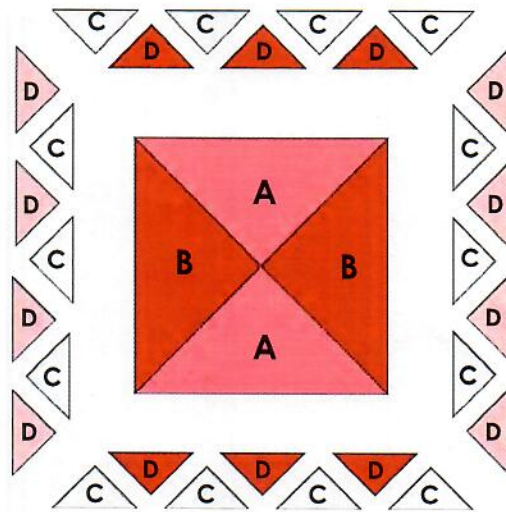
3. Lay out C and D triangles around the QST unit as shown, alternating between fabrics.

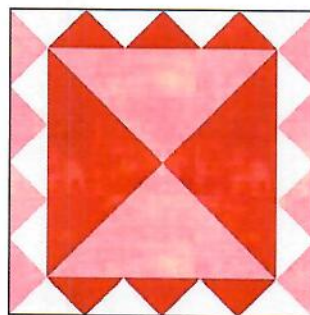
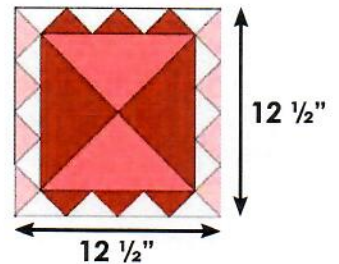
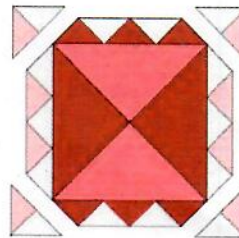
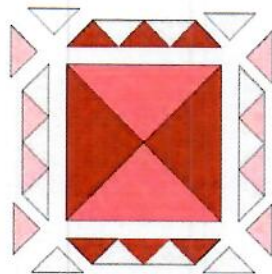
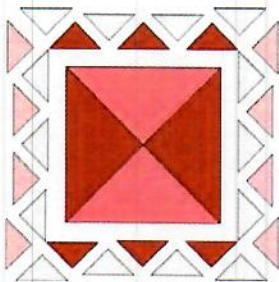
4. Once you have confirmed that the layout is correct, begin sewing the top, bottom and side triangle units together as shown. Sew the C/D triangles present at the four corners of the block together as shown leaving those separate from the side units at this time.



5. Attach top, bottom and side triangle units to the QST unit. Press outward and away from the QST unit. (Please note that the C/D triangles are not sewn to the corners at this step.)

6. Attach the C/D triangle units to the four corners to complete the block.

7. Press the C/D triangle units outward to complete the block. Completed block should measure 12 1/2" x 12 1/2" unfinished.
