

Mystery #24 Part 4

11. Arrange the corner units from above, the $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6" (H) rectangles and $1\frac{1}{2}$ " (F) square as shown. (Figure 9)

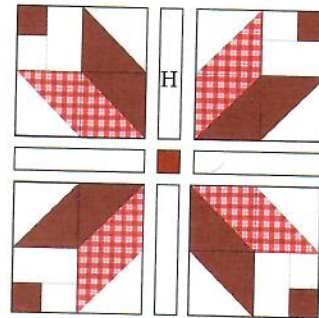

12. Sew together into rows; sew rows together. Press seams toward (H) rectangles. (Fig. 10)
Make (4) $12\frac{1}{2}$ " Nordic Star blocks.

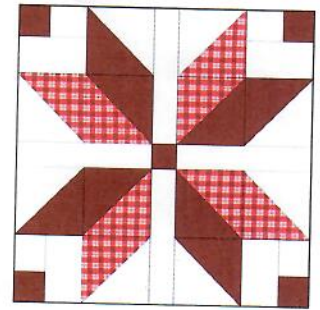

Table runner assembly

13. Sew the Nordic Star blocks and $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " sashing rectangles together to create the table runner. (Figure 11)

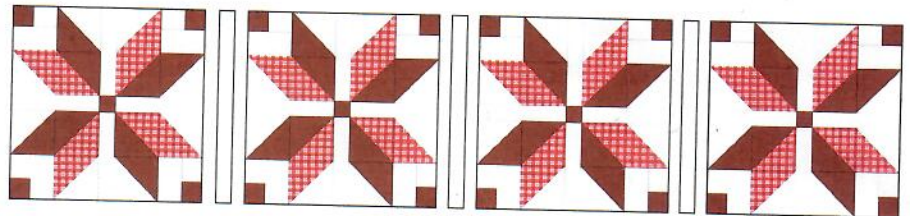

14. Join the $1\frac{3}{4}$ " wide border strips to form one long continuous strip.
15. Measure quilt length through the center, and cut two strips to that measurement. (It should be approximately $51\frac{1}{2}$ " long).
16. Sew border strips to each long side of the quilt and press towards the border.
17. Measure quilt width through the center including the borders and cut two strips to that measurement. (It should be approximately 15" wide).
18. Sew borders to the remaining sides of quilt.
19. Baste, quilt and bind the table runner. I quilted straight lines $\frac{1}{2}$ " apart.
