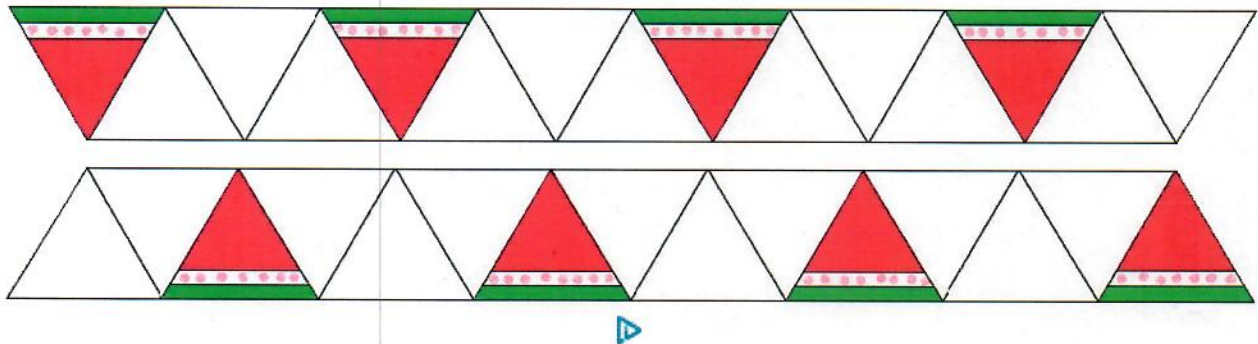


Mystery #29 Part 3

Step 4

Set aside (4) units. Arrange your remaining triangles, as shown. And sew the triangles into two rows.

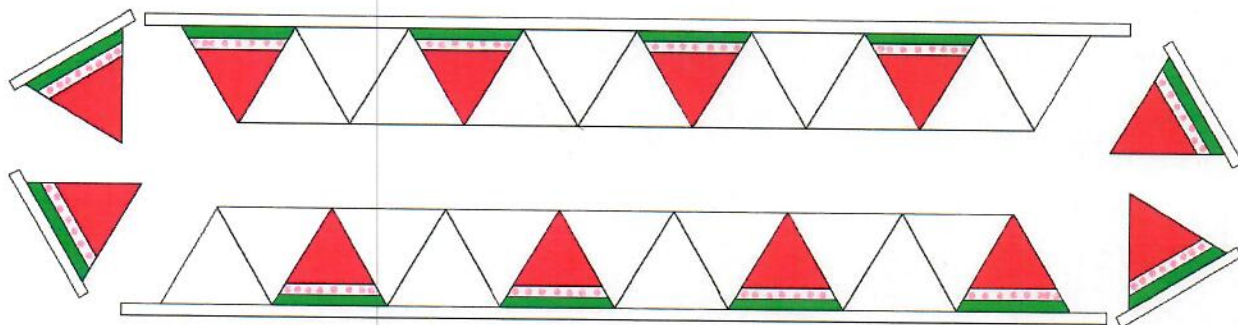
Step 5

Sew the (2) 21" strips of border fabric to the (2) full WOF border strips, end to end.

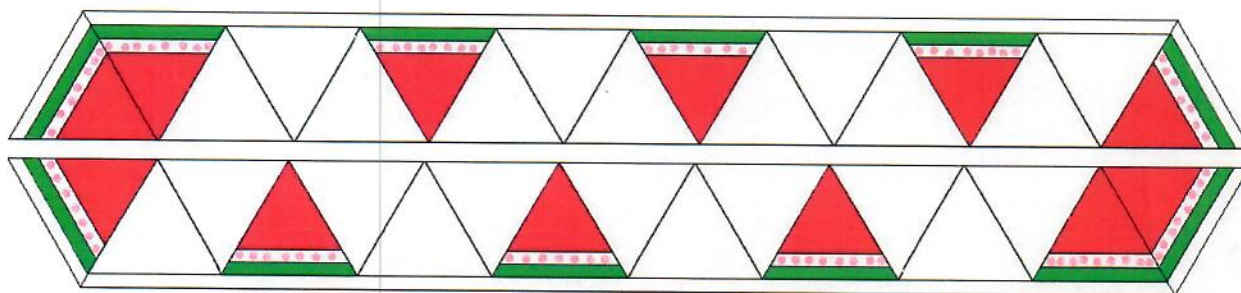
Step 6

When sewing on the borders, make sure to leave at least a 1" overhang on the ends. Sew the 10.5" border pieces on the ends of the (4) watermelon triangles that were set aside in Step 4. Press seams open and trim as you did in Step 3. Sew the long borders on the sides of the rows. Press seams toward outside border on the long row pieces and trim as you did in Step 3.



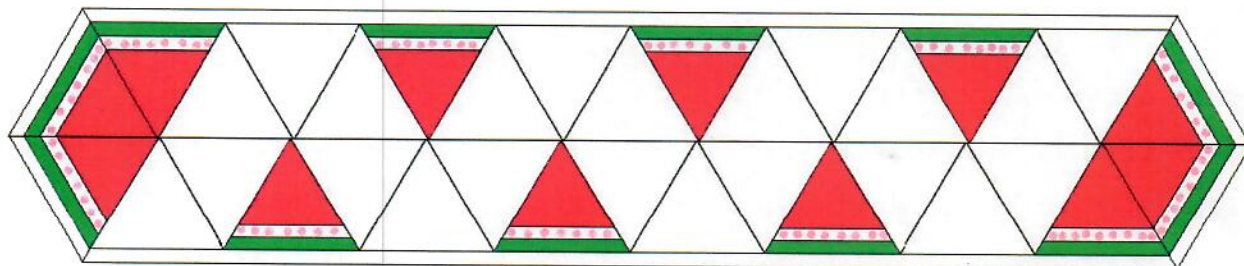
Step 7

Sew the triangles onto the ends of the rows.



Step 8

Sew the two rows together to complete the top.



Step 9

Sandwich the Backing, Batting and Top. Baste. And quilt.

Step 10

Apply the binding. Enjoy!
