

Crisscross Halloween Table Runner or 4 Placemats



- 1/2 yard of 4 different fabrics, three will be used for piecing, and one for binding
 - Backing & Batting
- From each of the fabrics for the front cut (2) 7 1/4" strips wof
- Subcut these into 7 1/4" squares.

You will create each block in the same manner, but using different fabrics. You will need to create a selection of Block A, B, C & D. The number of blocks will vary depending on whether you are making a set of four placemats or a table runner, and also the length of the table runner.

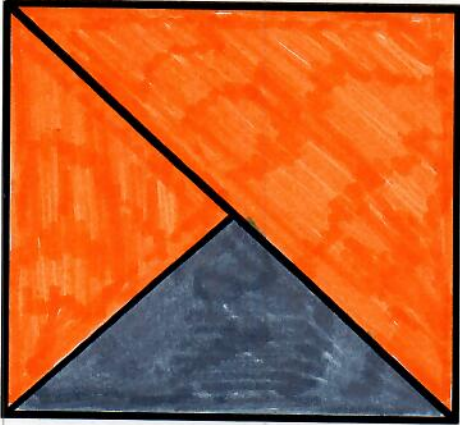
The following instructions are for constructing "block C & D"

Place a black print and light grey (background) fabric right sides together and mark along one diagonal. Stitch 1/4" seam either side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line and press seams to the dark fabric. Square to 6 7/8" (if necessary). Now trim down (2) orange squares to 6 7/8" squares. Place right sides together on the pieced square and draw a diagonal line (opposite from the original stitched line). Stitch 1/4" either side of the new drawn line. Cut on the drawn line and press seams to the new large triangle. Square to 6 1/2" (if necessary).

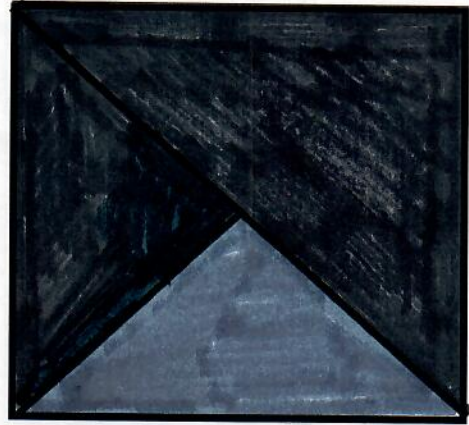
To create block A and B you will repeat the above steps but you will duplicate the orange or the black fabric as shown in the diagrams.

Repeat until you have enough blocks to create either a set of 4 placemats or a table runner. The placemats are using 6 blocks for each placemat. One A, one B, two C and two D.

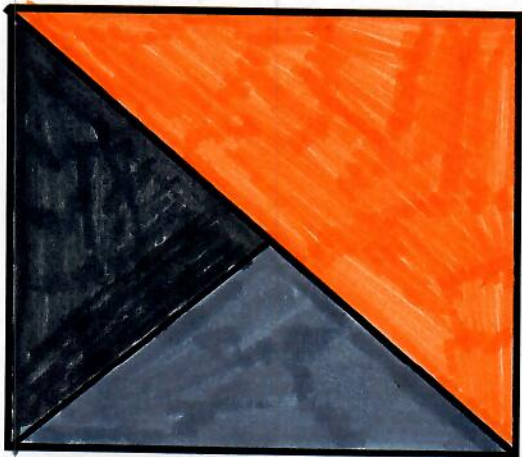
The table runner will depend on the length you wish to create.



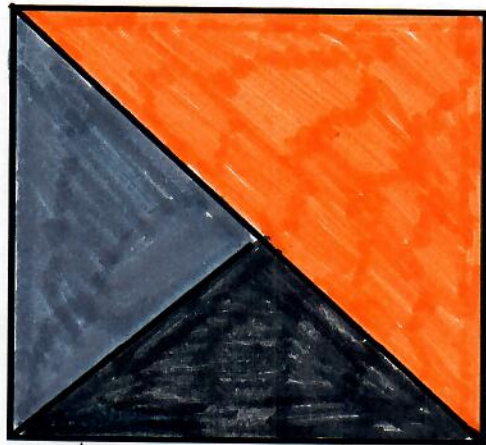
BLOCK A
