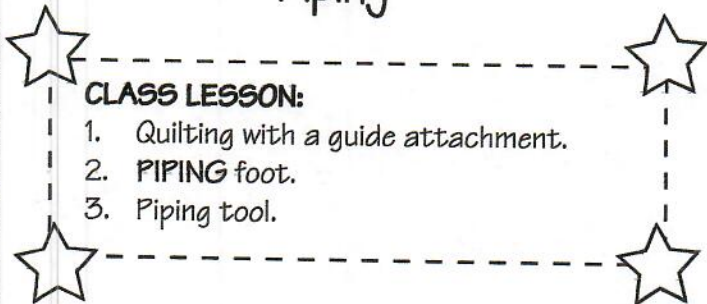

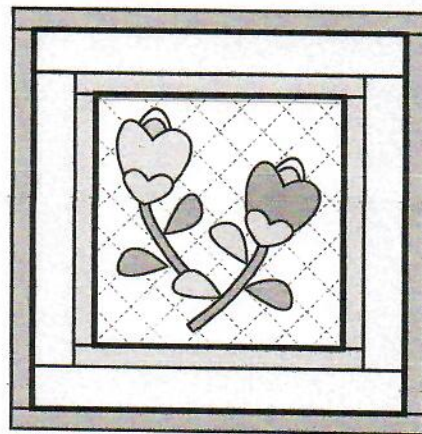
Featured Foot: Piping




CLASS LESSON:

1. Quilting with a guide attachment.
2. **PIPING** foot.
3. Piping tool.

PREQUILT BACKGROUNDS:

1. Mark the 14" square background block with an air soluble marker on the diagonal in both directions.
2. Suggested stitch  or use one of your choice, changing the width and length.
3. After stitching the first line, stitch the second drawn line. Place the guide attachment on the appropriate foot, measure 1" from needle, lock the guide in place.
4. Place the guide on the previously sewn line, stitch again, 1" from first line. Repeat sewing to create a cross hatching grid. Trim block to 12½" square.

PIPING TOOL:

After stitching piping, use the groove on the tool to trim off excess fabric leaving a ¼" seam allowance (refer to the packaged instructions).

OPTION: use the piping tool instructions for making the piping.

BLOCK:

1. Line up the raw edges of the block and cording. Move the needle position closer to the cord to cover the previous stitches; sew the two side pieces in place. Sew two piping pieces to the top and bottom of the block.

2. Cut then sew to the block;

border #1 - 2 - 1½" x 12½" strips
 2 - 1½" x 14½" strips

3. Cut then sew to the block:

border #2 - 2 - 2½" x 14½" strips
 2 - 2½" x 18½" strips

4. Make another piping in the same or contrasting color to go between border #2 and #3. Sew to border #2.

5. Cut then sew to the block:

border #3 - 1½" x 18½" strips
 1½" x 20½" strips

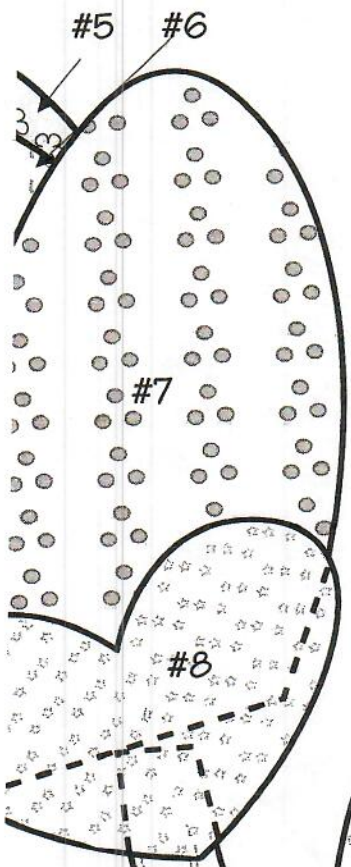
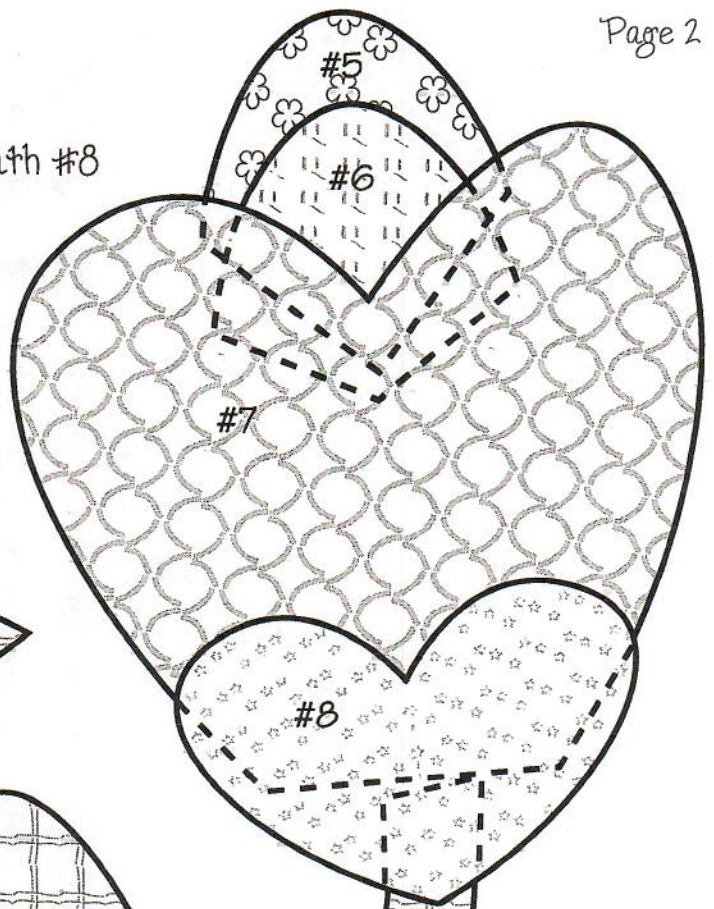
PIPING:

1. Cut fabric strips 1½" wide. Cut the strips longer than needed, trimming to length when attaching to the block. Bias strips are only needed if going around a curve.
2. Attach piping foot.
3. Cording: use #5 Pearl Cotton or Gimp.
4. Fold the fabric around the cord. Place under the groove on the foot. You may need to move the needle so it isn't stitching on top of the cording. Then move it back when attaching the piping to the block.

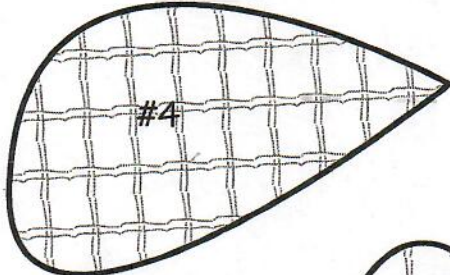

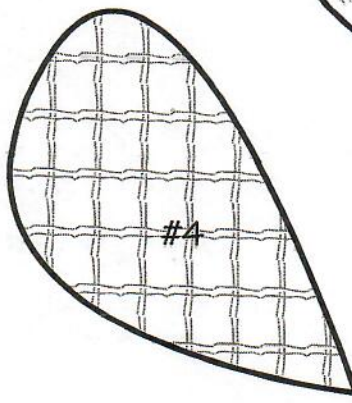
Piping foot



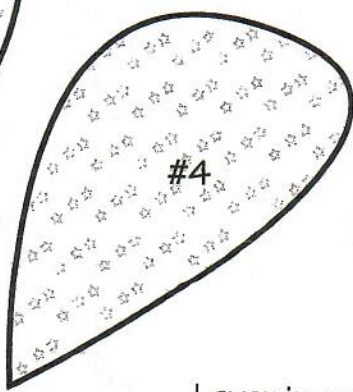
Leaf pattern that goes off the page.



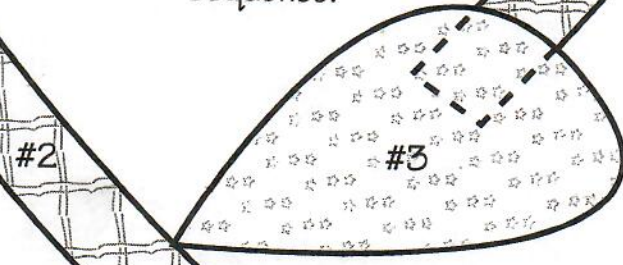
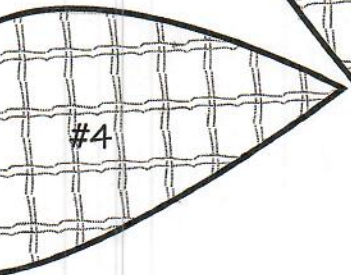
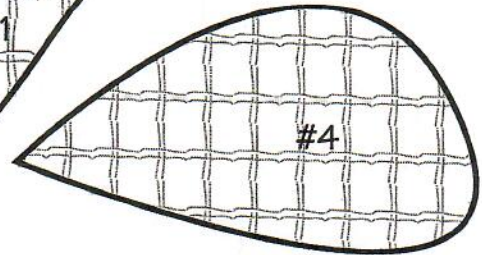
Design given in reverse




Dash lines represent template underneath.





Layer in numbered sequence.
