

Serged Framed Christmas Placemats and Napkins

Fabric Kit \$18.99 (makes 2)

Outer Fabric - 1 yard

Inner Fabric - $\frac{3}{4}$ yard

Heat N Bond

Ultra Soft Fusible Light Weight Batting

1 spool glamour metallic thread

2 spools of regular serger thread

Cutting per placemat

Outer Fabric - 16" x 21"

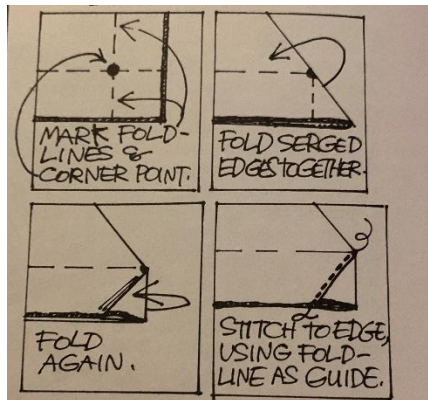
Inner Fabric - 11" x 16"

Heat N Bond - 11" x 16"

Ultra Soft Fusible Light Weight Batting - 16" x 21"

15" circle from outer fabric and inner fabric

- Fuse the ultra soft fusible to the wrong side of the outer fabric.
- Fuse the heat n bond to the wrong side of the inner fabric.
- Set up your serger for a three thread wide stitch with the decorative metallic thread in the upper looper, and the regular thread in the lower looper and left needle. Test sew. You will want to create a nice satin stitch look so might want to shorten your stitch length a little.
- Serge all 4 sides of the outer fabric, corners will not be seen, so you can just serge on and off. Do not trim anything off.
- Press well. Press a 2" hem on all the borders towards the center.
- Make the 2" corner points with a marker.
- Fold the corners right sides together aligning the two serged edges and fold the corners as below:



- Using the foldline as a guide, stitch along the diagonal along the fold. Backstitch at the serged edge.
- Trim, angling the trim to a point to minimize the bulk in the seam. Press seam open.
- Turn corners right sides out and press. Once you are happy with your corners, remove the heat n bond from the inner fabric and slide into place. Fuse only when you are happy.
- Straight stitch on the sewing machine machine to hold borders in place, using the needle stitch from the serged stitching as your guideline.

NAPKINS

Place napkin circles wrong sides together. Stitch a rolled hem stitch around the circumference. Fold into a Christmas tree!
