Union St. Sachel Pattern

Fabric:

Exterior: 3 fat quarters or 5/8 yd (44" wide) or 1 yard 27" wide

Lining and Pockets: 3 fat quarters or 5/8 yard (44" wide)

Contrast

- straps Handle & handle anchors: ½ yard (44" wide cotton) OR 27" wide cork/vinyl

Fusible Fleece: ½ yd (45" wide)

Light wt Fusible woven interfacing such as Pellon SF101

- 3 yds 20" or 1 5/8 yd if using cork/vinyl

Heavy wt Stabilizer such as Pellon 71F

- 1/4 yd 20" wide

Additional Supplies Needed

- -1-8" or longer zipper
- 1 magnetic snap

- 3 metal snaps sets of desired size (I used magnetic)
- $4-1\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle rings
- 6 bag feet
- 6 optional rivets

Optional supplies – helpful but not needed

- Turning tool
- Fabric glue
- Temporary adhesive spray
- Adhesive basting tape
- Pressing cloth
