



## Sweet Wraps:

### Mystery Mummy and Pumpkin Patch

Our Sweet Wraps are autumn decor for Sweet Tubes and more! Made with crisscrossed strips of raw-edge fabric, these giftable wraps can be tied with coordinating ribbon around cylinders of all sizes. Meet the Mystery Mummy, his friendly eyes shyly peeking from soft layers of fabric, then harvest a Pumpkin Patch with darling applique stems! Both designs come in x-small, small, and medium sizes for a variety of projects.

#### Materials Needed X-SMALL: MYSTERY MUMMY

##### HOOP:

4 x 4  
 Embroidery Field: 3.90 x 3.57" or 99.1 x 90.7 mm  
 Finished Size: 3¾ x 4¼"

##### STABILIZER:

Firm Tear-away

##### FABRIC:

Fabric 1: Background 1 Fat Sixteenth  
 Fabrics 2-4: Mummy Wrap 1 Fat Sixteenth each

##### KIMBERBELL® PRODUCTS:

- KDKB146 Sweet Tubes (1) Large
- KDKB100 Ribbon (2) 12" Pieces
- KDTL100 Paper Tape

##### OTHER:

- Felt, Black (1) 9 x 12" Sheet
- Permanent Topper (1) White
- Water-soluble Topper (2) 6 x 6"
- Fusible Woven Interfacing

#### Cutting Instructions X-SMALL: MYSTERY MUMMY

##### Fabric 1:

Background cut (1) 4½ x 4½"

##### Fabrics 2-4:

Mummy Wrap cut (1) 6 x 6" each

##### Black Felt:

Background cut (1) 5 x 5"  
 Back cut (1) 5 x 5"

##### White Permanent Topper:

Eyes cut (1) 3½ x 3½"

**Note:** Extra fabric was given for strips. Use a variety of strips with both sides frayed for a scrappy look.

## Pattern Key

A Fabric Scrap is 5 x 5"

A Fat Sixteenth is 9 x 11"

A Fat Eighth is 9 x 21"

A Fat Quarter is 18 x 21"



Indicates thread color change.



Indicates bobbin color change.



Corresponds with the specific embroidery machine step.

To eliminate shadowing on the Mummy design, we used a permanent topping such as Color Keep, Stabilize It!, CoverUp, or Top Cover.

To provide extra structure to the fabric, reduce puckering, and reduce shadowing, we recommend using a fusible woven interfacing such as Shapeflex®. With iron, fuse interfacing to **wrong side** of Background Fabric. This will be used in addition to the required stabilizer.

### Materials Needed SMALL: MYSTERY MUMMY

**HOOP:** 5 x 7  
Embroidery Field: 4.90 x 4.45" or 124.5 x 113.0 mm  
Finished Size: 4¾ x 5¼"

**STABILIZER:** Firm Tear-away

#### FABRIC:

Fabric 1: Background 1 Fat Eighth  
Fabrics 2-4: Mummy Wrap 1 Fat Sixteenth *each*

- Felt, Black (1) 9 x 12" Sheet

### Cutting Instructions SMALL: MYSTERY MUMMY

#### Fabric 1:

Background cut (1) 6 x 6"

#### Fabrics 2-4:

Mummy Wrap cut (1) 7 x 7" *each*

#### Black Felt:

Background cut (1) 6 x 6"  
Back cut (1) 6 x 6"

#### White Permanent Topper:

Eyes cut (1) 3½ x 3½"

**Note:** Extra fabric was given for strips. Use a variety of strips with both sides frayed for a scrappy look.

### Materials Needed MEDIUM: MYSTERY MUMMY

**HOOP:** 6 x 10  
Embroidery Field: 5.60 x 5.08" or 142.2 x 129.0 mm  
Finished Size: 5½ x 6"

**STABILIZER:** Firm Tear-away

#### FABRIC:

Fabric 1: Background 1 Fat Eighth  
Fabrics 2-4: Mummy Wrap 1 Fat Sixteenth *each*

- KDKB100 Ribbon (2) 16" Pieces
- KDTL100 Paper Tape

#### OTHER:

- Felt, Black (1) 9 x 12" Sheet
- Permanent Topper (1) White
- Water-soluble Topper (2) 8 x 8"
- Can (1)
- Fusible Woven Interfacing

### Cutting Instructions MEDIUM: MYSTERY MUMMY

#### Fabric 1:

Background cut (1) 6½ x 6"

#### Fabrics 2-4:

Mummy Wrap cut (1) 8 x 8" *each*

#### Black Felt:

Background cut (1) 7 x 6"  
Back cut (1) 7 x 6"

#### White Permanent Topper:

Eyes cut (1) 4 x 4"

**Note:** Extra fabric was given for strips. Use a variety of strips with both sides frayed for a scrappy look.

### Materials Needed X-SMALL: PUMPKIN PATCH

**HOOP:** 4 x 4  
Embroidery Field: 3.37 x 3.90" or 85.6 x 99.1 mm  
Finished Size: 3¼ x 4¾"

**STABILIZER:** Firm Tear-away

#### FABRIC:

Fabric 1: Background 1 Fat Sixteenth  
Fabrics 2-6: Pumpkin Rhind Fabric Scrap *each*  
Fabric 7: Stem Fabric Scrap

- KDKB105 Ribbon (2) 12" Pieces
- KDTL100 Paper Tape

#### OTHER:

- Felt, Orange (1) 9 x 12" Sheet

### Cutting Instructions X-SMALL: PUMPKIN PATCH

#### Fabric 1:

Background cut (1) 4½ x 4½"

#### Fabrics 2-6:

Pumpkin Rind cut (1) 5 x 5" *each*

#### Fabric 7:

Stem cut (1) 2½ x 2½"

#### Orange Felt:

Background cut (1) 5 x 5"  
Back cut (1) 5 x 5"

**Note:** Extra fabric was given for strips. Use a variety of strips with both sides frayed for a scrappy look.

## Materials Needed SMALL: PUMPKIN PATCH

**HOOP:** 5 x 7  
Embroidery Field: 3.90 x 4.52" or 99.1 x 114.8 mm  
Finished Size: 4¼ x 5¾"

**STABILIZER:** Firm Tear-away

### FABRIC:

Fabric 1: Background 1 Fat Eighth  
Fabrics 2-6: Pumpkin Rhind 1 Fat Sixteenth each  
Fabric 7: Stem Fabric Scrap

- KDKB146 Sweet Tubes (1) Large
- KDKB105 Ribbon (2) 12" Pieces
- KDTL100 Paper Tape

### OTHER:

- Felt, Orange (1) 9 x 12" Sheet
- Water-soluble Topper (2) 7 x 7"

## Cutting Instructions SMALL: PUMPKIN PATCH

### Fabric 1:

Background cut (1) 6 x 6"

### Fabrics 2-6:

Pumpkin Rhind cut (1) 7 x 7" each

### Fabric 7:

Stem cut (1) 2½ x 2½"

### Orange Felt:

Background cut (1) 6 x 6"  
Back cut (1) 6 x 6"

**Note:** Extra fabric was given for strips. Use a variety of strips with both sides frayed for a scrappy look.

## Materials Needed MEDIUM: PUMPKIN PATCH

**HOOP:** 6 x 10  
Embroidery Field: 5.67 x 6.48" or 144.0 x 164.6 mm  
Finished Size: 6 x 6¾"

**STABILIZER:** Firm Tear-away

### FABRIC:

Fabric 1: Background 1 Fat Eighth  
Fabrics 2-6: Pumpkin Rhind 1 Fat Sixteenth each  
Fabric 7: Stem Fabric Scrap

### KIMBERBELL® PRODUCTS:

- KDKB105 Ribbon (2) 16" Pieces
- KDTL100 Paper Tape

### OTHER:

- Felt, Orange (2) 9 x 12" Sheet
- Water-soluble Topper (2) 8 x 8"
- Can (1)

## Cutting Instructions MEDIUM: PUMPKIN PATCH

### Fabric 1:

Background cut (1) 6½ x 6½"

### Fabrics 2-6:

Pumpkin Rhind cut (1) 8 x 8" each

### Fabric 7:

Stem cut (1) 2½ x 2½"

### Orange Felt:

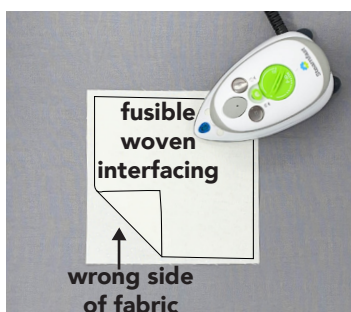
Background cut (1) 8 x 8"  
Back cut (1) 8 x 8"

**Note:** Extra fabric was given for strips. Use a variety of strips with both sides frayed for a scrappy look.

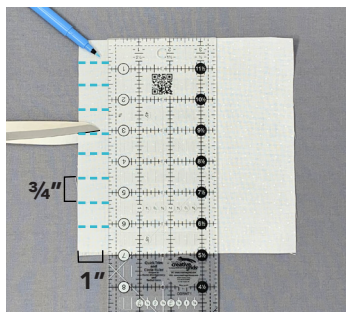
**Mystery Mummy:** for other design see color chart on page 8.

## 1. Prepare the Following:

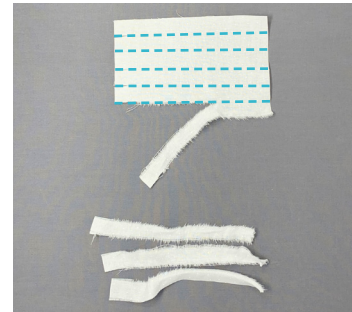
**Note:** For Small measure ½", Medium Measure ¾" and Large measure 1" in **Direction Steps 1B & 1C.**



**A.** With iron, fuse woven interfacing to **wrong side** of Background Fabric.



**B.** Mark the Mummy Wrap Fabric every ¾" along one edge with a water-soluble or heat sensitive pen. Cut approximately 1" down on each mark along edge.



**C.** Tear Mummy Wrap Fabric on each mark to create approximately (5-8) strips. (Due to raw edge design, do not use end pieces.)

## 2. Embroidery Instructions:

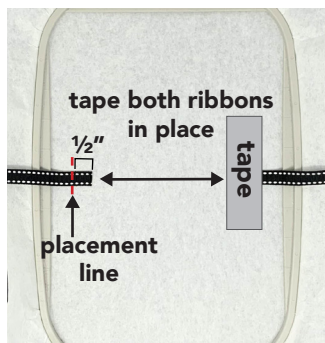


- A.** Hoop stabilizer only. Load the KDEX104\_5x7\_MysteryMummy\_SweetsandTreatsWrap embroidery file into the machine.

**Note:** The 5 x 7 version was used in this example. Follow the same instructions for the 4 x 4 or 6 x 10.

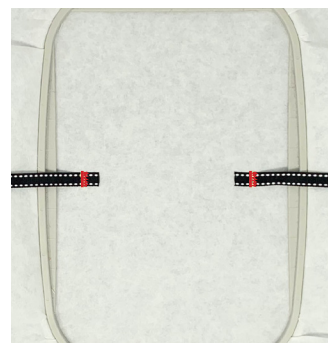


- B.** Stitch **the ribbon placement lines** directly on top of stabilizer.



- C.** Place ends of the Ribbons approximately  $\frac{1}{2}$ " past placement lines. Tape in place completely covering the placement lines to help prevent presser foot from catching.

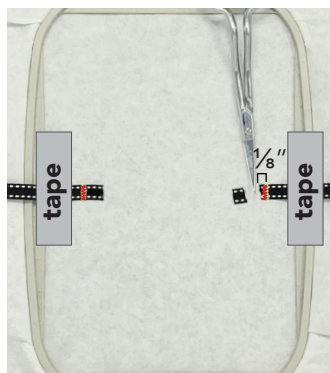
**Note:** When using printed ribbon, place ribbon **right side up**.



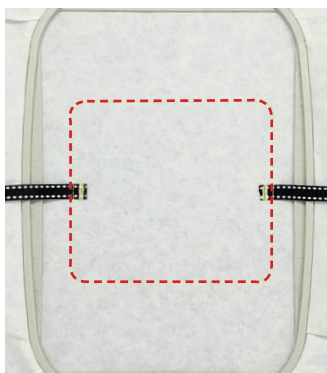
- D.** Stitch **the ribbon tack-down lines**. Carefully remove tape.



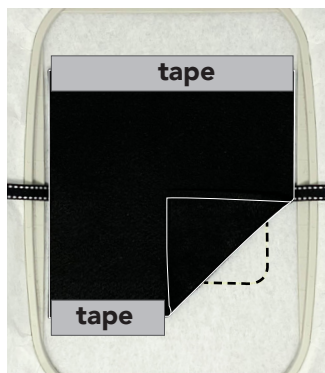
## 3.



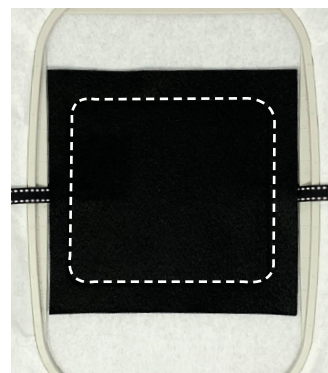
- A.** Trim ends  $\frac{1}{8}$ " from the stitch line. Tape both Ribbons outside of the tack-down line to prevent the presser foot from catching.



- B.** Stitch **the felt placement line** directly on top of stabilizer. Remove tape.



- C.** Place the Felt Background completely covering the placement line. Tape in place.



- D.** Change thread to desired color. Stitch **the felt background tack-down line**. Remove tape.



**Note:** This stitch will be seen in final project.



## 4.

- Stitch **the mummy placement line**



## 5.

- Place the Background Fabric **right side up**, completely covering the placement line



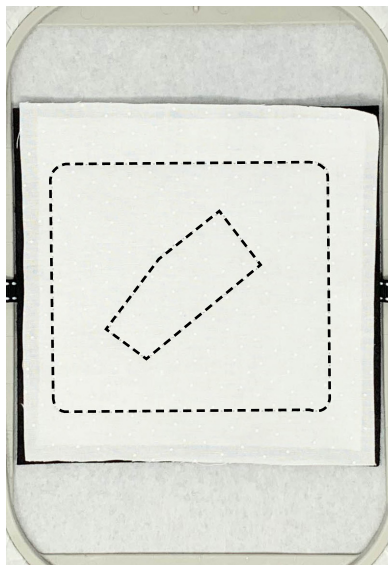


# 6.

- Change thread to desired color
- Stitch **the mummy tack-down line**



**Note:** Use the same color thread for the tack-down line that you plan to use for the decorative outline. A different color of thread will show through the decorative stitch. (Shown in black for illustration purposes only.)



# 7.

- Trim fabric close to the stitch line
- Trim fabric close to the inner eye box stitch line (Shown in red.)

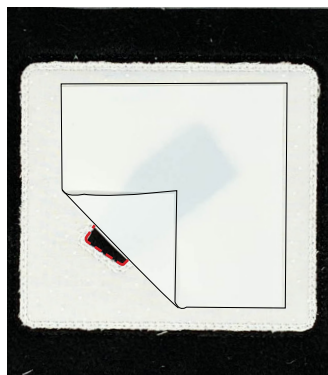


# 8.



- A. Stitch *the mummy background decorative outline.***

**Note:** Shown in red for illustration purposes only.

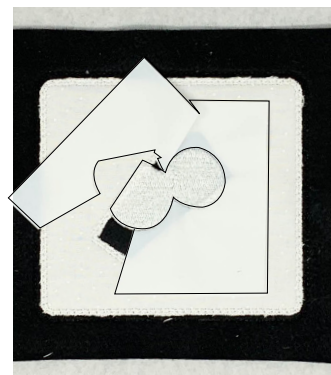


- B. Place the Permanent Topping completely covering the inner eye box.**



- C. Change thread to desired color. Stitch *the the eyes decorative fill.***

**Note:** Shown in black for illustration purposes only.



- D. Tear away excess topping.**

# 9.

- Change thread to desired color
- Stitch **the pupils decorative fill**

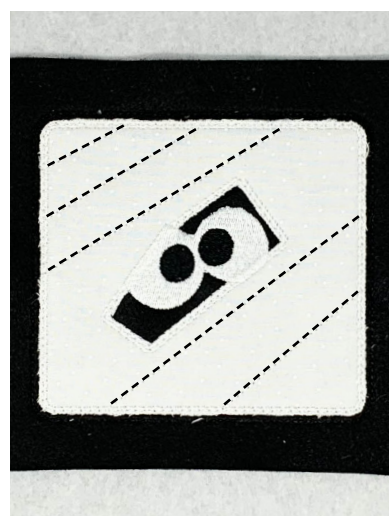


# 10.

- Change thread to match Background Fabric
- Stitch **the wrap strips placement lines**



**Note:** Shown in black for illustration purposes only.



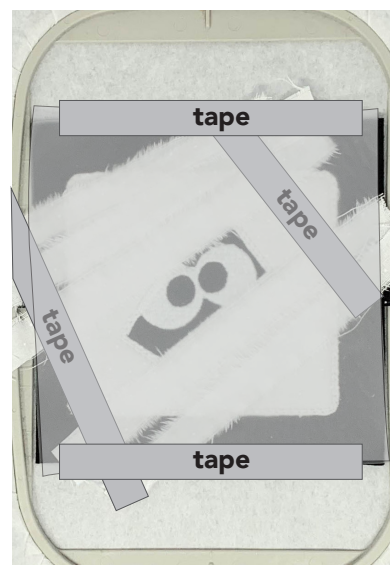
# 11.

- Place **(5)** Wrap Strips **right side up**, centering the strips over the placement lines
- Tape strip ends in place



# 12.

- Place the Water-soluble Topping, completely covering the design
- Tape in place



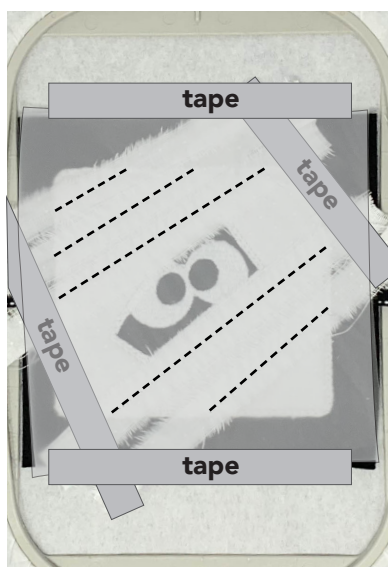
# 13.

- Stitch **the wrap strips tack-down lines** (Do not remove tape or topper at this time.)

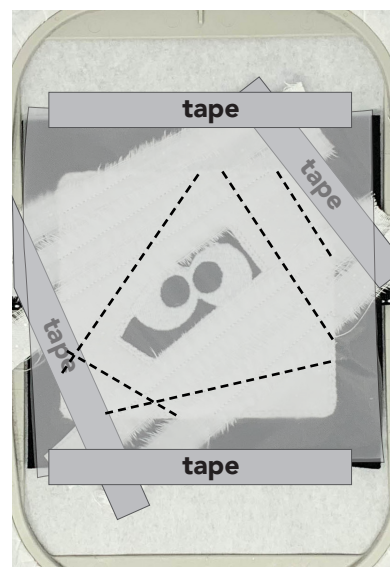

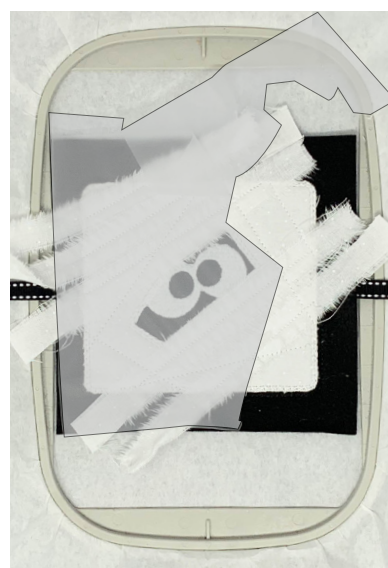

# 15.

- Remove tape
- Tear away excess Water-soluble Topping

**Note:** When tearing away water-soluble topping, small pieces may remain on strips. At the end of the project, spray with water to dissolve.



# 16.

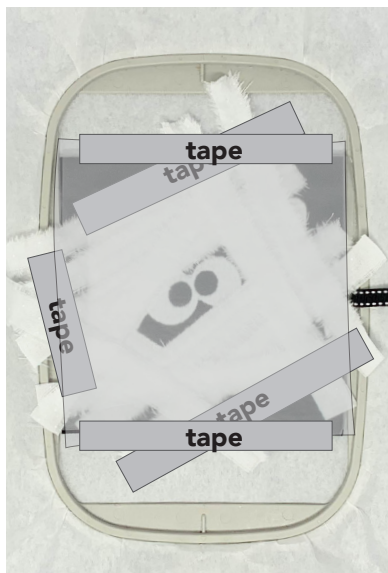
- Place **(5)** Wrap Strips **right side up**, centering the strips over the placement lines
- Tape strip ends in place





## 17.

- Place the Water-soluble Topping, completely covering the design
- Tape in place

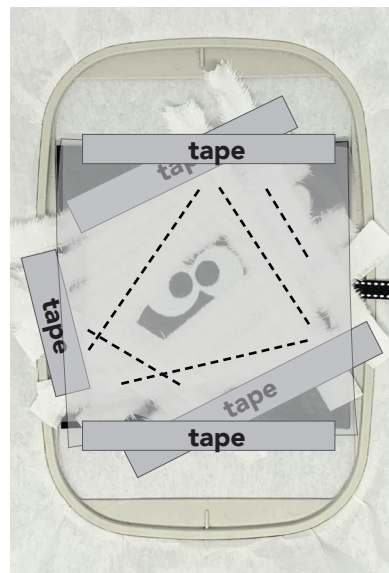


## 18.

- Stitch **the wrap strips tack-down lines** (Do not remove tape or topper at this time.)

## 19.

- Remove tape
- Tear away excess Water-soluble Topping

**Note:** When tearing away water-soluble topping, small pieces may remain on strips. At the end of the project, spray with water to dissolve.



## 20.

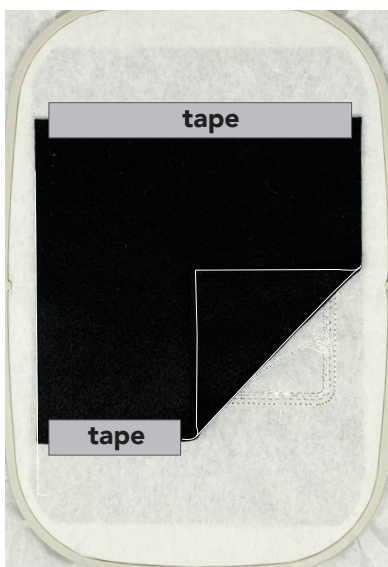
- Using the Background Fabric as a guide, trim excess wrap strip ends around perimeter of design



front of hoop

## 21.

- Remove hoop from machine
- Turn hoop to **back**
- Place the Back Felt on **top** of the stabilizer, completely covering the project
- Tape in place



back of hoop

## 22.

- Return hoop to machine
- Change thread to match color used in **Direction Step 3D**
- Change bobbin thread to match top thread
- Stitch **the final stitch outline**



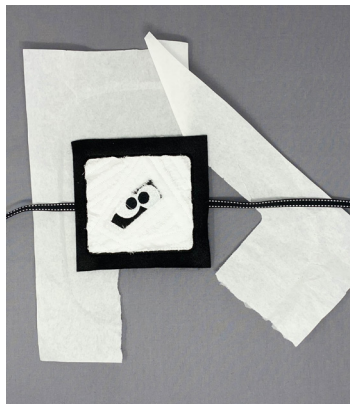

# 23.



**A.** Remove project from hoop. Remove tape from **back** of project. Tear away excess stabilizer from between the felt.



**B.** Trim felt approximately  $\frac{1}{8}$ " outside of the final stitch outline. **(Do not trim ribbons.)**

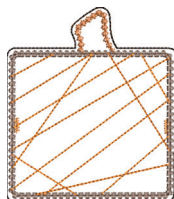


**C.** Fill large Sweet Tube with desired treat. Using Ribbons, tie Sweet Wrap to Sweet Tube.

  - **Place fabric**
9. Pumpkin Tack-down Line
  - **Trim fabric**
10. Pumpkin Decorative Outline
11. Pumpkin Strips A Placement Line
  - **Place (7) strips**
  - **Place water-soluble topping**
12. Pumpkin Strips A Tack-down Line
13. Pumpkin Strips B Placement Line
  - **Tear-away excess water-soluble topping**
  - **Place (5) strips**
  - **Place water-soluble topping**
14. Pumpkin Strips B Tack-down Line
  - **Tear-away excess water-soluble topping**
  - **Trim excess strips**
  - **Place Felt on back**
15. Final Stitch Outline
