*Beginning Quilting Classes are now being offered in January. This is a four-week class, starting on Tuesday, January 23rd from 6 – 9 pm. Our meeting dates are January 23, January 30, February 6, and February 13th. In our beginning quilting class we will be learning the basics of quilting together. Learn about fabric, notions, supplies, and details about the fundamentals of sewing. In our class we will be making a table runner using a variety of basic blocks, followed by completing our individual runner. Everyone will need to be able to thread and make a bobbin using their sewing machine before class. This will be a very informative class. Space is limited to better assist our sewers. The dates are scheduled for -


Kick Off to our NEW Quilt Along – Thursday, February 1 and Friday, February 2 - blocks 1 and 2 (pick one day only to attend) starting at 10 am and sew until 3 pm.

Thursday, February 15 and Friday, February 16 – Blocks 3 and 4 (pick one day only to attend) Thursday, February 29 and Friday, March 1 – Blocks 5 and 6 (pick one day only to attend) Thursday, March 14 and Friday, March 15 – Blocks 7 and 8 (pick one day only to attend) Wednesday, March 27 and Thursday, March 28 (Easter weekend) – Blocks 9 and 10 (pick one day only to attend)

Thursday, April 4 and Friday, April 5 – Blocks 11 and 12 (pick one day only to attend) Thursday, April 18 and Friday, April 19 – Sashing and Borders (pick one day only to attend)

Patterns will be provided each time we meet, use your scraps or purchase new fabric it is up to you. The cost to participate is only \$7 a week for both block patterns. Sorry, fabrics are not included.
