Enchantment by Stephanie Ryan



Full Quilt: 78 1/2" x 90"



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Enchantment

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvege to selvege, unless stated otherwise.

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - PLEASE NOTE: Panels do not always print the size intended. For this pattern, panels have a coping border added then trimmed so they will fit the quilt correctly.

Fussy cut 1/4" beyond outside edges of 4 panels to approximately 11-1/2" square

Fabric B - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvege: (2) 6-3/4" x 91" and (2) 6-3/4" x 80" floral borders

Fabric C - Cut (4) 3-1/2" strips
Cut (3) 3-1/2" strips, subcut (32) 3-1/2" squares
Cut (8) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 87-1/2" and (2) 2" x 79" borders

Fabric D - Cut (3) 6-1/2" strips, subcut (17) 6-1/2" squares

Fabric E - Cut (5) 3-1/2" strips, from 1 strip subcut (4) 3-1/2" squares

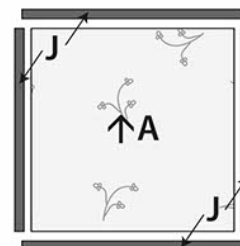
Fabrics F, G, and I - From each fabric:
Cut (8) 3-1/2" strips

Fabric H - Cut (1) 3-1/2" strip, subcut (4) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces
Cut (7) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 72-1/2" and (2) 2" x 63-1/2" borders

Fabric J - Cut (9) 2-1/2" strips (binding)
Cut (6) 1-1/2" strips, subcut (8) 1-1/2" x 14" and (8) 1-1/2" x 12" strips

2. Piecing Order:

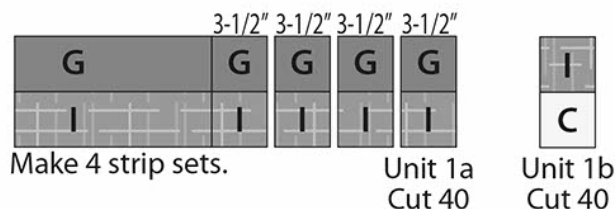
1. Stitch **Fabric J** 1-1/2" x 12" strips to sides of a **Fabric A** panel. Trim strip ends even. Add 1-1/2" x 14" **Fabric J** strips to top and bottom of panel. **Trim bordered panel to 12-1/2" square (unfinished)**. Make a total of 4 **Block 1**.



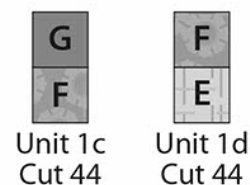
Block 1 - Make 4

Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.

2. Sew **Fabrics G** and **I** 3-1/2" strips together lengthwise. Make a total of 4 strip sets. From these, cut (40) 3-1/2" wide Unit 1a (3-1/2" x 6-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make 4 strip sets using **Fabrics C** and **I** 3-1/2" strips and cut 40 Unit 1b.



3. In the same manner, make 4 strip sets of each fabric combination and cut 44 each Units 1c and 1d.



4. Stitch 1 each Units 1a and 1b together as shown. Make a total of 40 Unit 2a (6-1/2" square unfinished).

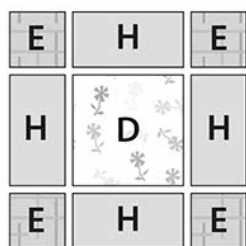


5. In the same manner, make 44 each Unit 2b with the units indicated.



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6. Arrange 1 **Fabric D** 6-1/2" square, 4 **Fabric E** 3-1/2" squares, and 4 **Fabric H** 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces in 3 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together to complete **Block 2** (12-1/2" square unfinished).



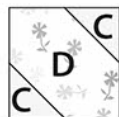
Block 2 - Make 1

7. Draw a diagonal line across the wrong side of 32 **Fabric C** 3-1/2" squares.



Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.

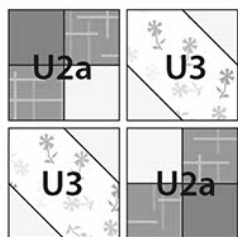
8. Arrange 2 marked **Fabric C** 3-1/2" squares on opposite corners of a **Fabric D** 6-1/2" square as shown.



Unit 3
Make 16

Stitch along marked lines. Trim seam allowances to 1/4". Press triangles out. Make 16 Unit 3 (6-1/2" square unfinished).

9. Arrange 2 each Units 2a and 3 in 2 rows as shown. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 8 **Block 3** (12-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 3 - Make 8

10. Arrange 1 Unit 2a and 3 Unit 2b in 2 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make a total of 8 **Block 4** (12-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 4 - Make 8

11. Arrange 2 each Units 2a and 2b in 2 rows. Stitch into rows. Sew rows together. Make 4 **Block 5** (12-1/2" square unfinished).



Block 5 - Make 4

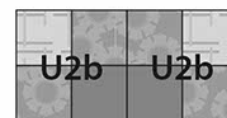
12. Sew a Unit 2a to a Unit 2b as shown. Make a total of 4 **Block 6a** (6-1/2" x 12-1/2" unfinished). In the same manner, make 4 each **Blocks 6b** and 2 **Block 7** with units indicated.

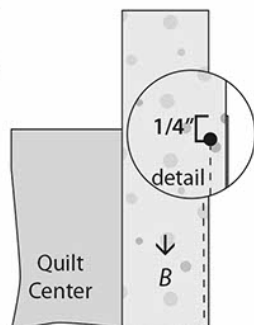
13. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 4) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.

14. Arrange blocks in 5 vertical rows. Stitch into vertical rows. Sew rows together completing quilt center (60-1/2" x 72-1/2" unfinished).

15. Sew **Fabric H** 2" x 72-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add **Fabric H** 2" x 63-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt center.

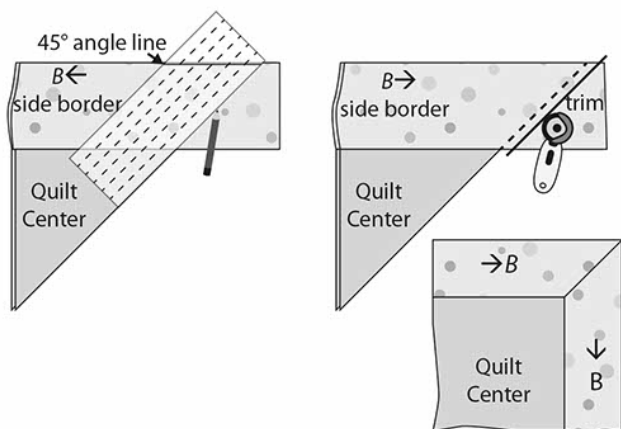
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16. Center **Fabric B** 6-3/4" x 91" borders on right and left sides of quilt center and **Fabric B** 6-3/4" x 80" borders on top and bottom of quilt center, referring to quilt image for positioning of stripe. Stitch borders to sides starting and stopping 1/4" from corners of quilt center. Do not trim. Press borders out.



*Letters in italics indicate wrong side of fabric.
Arrows indicate orientation of directional prints.*

17. Working with 1 corner at a time, fold the quilt right sides together so the outside edges of the borders line up. Using a 45-degree ruler, mark from the end of border seams to outer edges of borders. Stitch along marked line. Trim seam allowance to 1/4". Press corner seam open. Repeat on remaining corners.



18. Sew **Fabric C** 2" x 87-1/2" borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add **Fabric C** 2" x 79" borders to top and bottom of quilt.

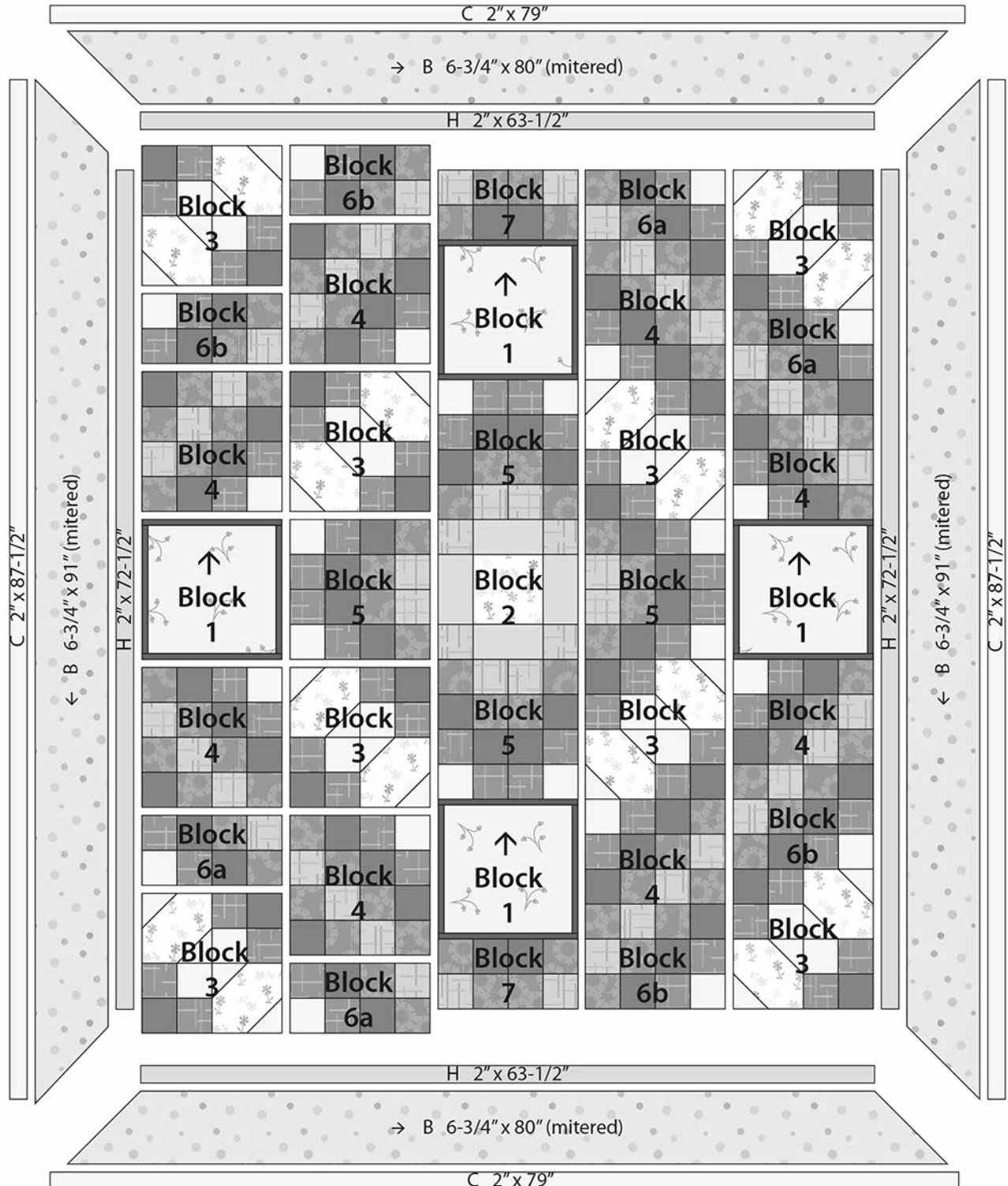
19. The quilt measures approximately 79" x 90-1/2" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric K**) approximately 8" larger than the top.

20. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric J**) and enjoy!!
