



HOW TO MAKE SURGICAL HATS

Fabric Requirements: Cottons only. No Flannels, No Glitter.
Please pre-wash all fabric in scent free detergent.

1. **CHILD SIZE:** Cut a circle that is 18 3/4" diameter.

Cut 1/4" elastic 18 1/2" long.

2. **INFANT SIZE:** Cut circle at 17 3/4" diameter and 1/4" elastic at 17 1/2" long.

3. Do a basting stitch 1/8" to 1/4" from outer edge. Stitch length of 5" or longer and leave long tails. (Hint: the Bernina 730 has a great basting stitch #21 that works great for this. Other machines may have a basting stitch as well. Check your manual)

4. Pull tails to gather the basting stitch so that the circle pulls up. This makes it easier to hem the circle.

5. Hem the fabric 1/2" around the diameter.

6. Thread elastic through the hem and secure elastic with a stitch and finish hem.
