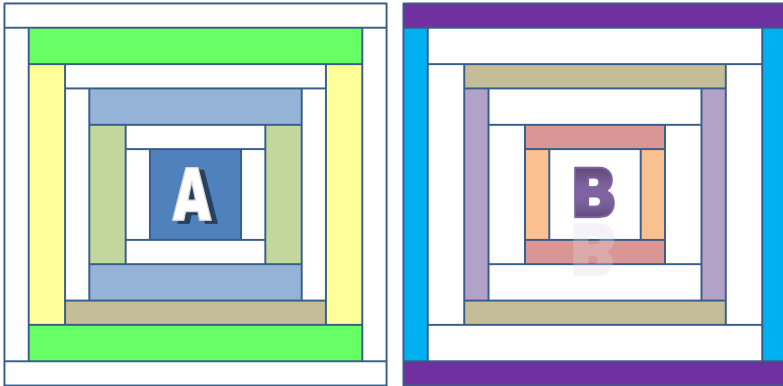

SUNDAY BEST QUILTS

March 2020 : *"Rainwashed"* Cutting Instructions



This quilt top uses two large blocks that are inverse colors of each other. The 10 blocks that make up Group "A" start with a colored fabric in the middle, while the 10 blocks that make up Group "B" blocks start with the background fabric in the middle.

Suggestion: cut the fabric for one block at a time and place in either a ziplock baggie or pinned together.

Cutting the Fabrics for Block "A"

To make one block you will need to cut the following pieces from the fat quarters:

- 2 - 2 x 6.5" rectangles
- 2 - 2 x 9.5" rectangle
- 2 - 2 x 11.5" rectangle
- 2 - 2 x 14.5" rectangle

Cut from the center block material:

- 1 - 4.25" square

From the background fabric cut:

- 2 - 1.5 x 4.5" rectangles
- 2 - 1.5 x 6.5" rectangles
- 2 - 1.5 x 9.5" rectangle
- 2 - 1.5 x 11.5" rectangle
- 2 - 1.5 x 14.5" rectangle
- 2 - 1.5 x 16.5" rectangle

Cutting the Fabrics for Block "B"

To make one block you will need to cut the following pieces from the background fabric:

- 1 - 4.25" square
- 2 - 2 x 6.5" rectangles
- 2 - 2 x 9.5" rectangle
- 2 - 2 x 11.5" rectangle
- 2 - 2 x 14.5" rectangle

From the fat quarters cut:

- 2 - 1.5 x 4.5" rectangles
- 2 - 1.5 x 6.5" rectangles
- 2 - 1.5 x 9.5" rectangle
- 2 - 1.5 x 11.5" rectangle
- 2 - 1.5 x 14.5" rectangle
- 2 - 1.5 x 16.5" rectangle
