Unfinished Business:

9. UDOT Culvert Discussion -- The culvert is ready for pickup. We need somebody to dig the trenches and Council Member Spackman needs to decide the best places for the culverts. We need a UDOT permit. Grover is \$10 a foot to bury the culvert but the homeowners should be the ones to pay. We have until December 1st to use the 18" corrugated pipe or UDOT will take it back. It is to run parallel to the highway. Council Member Spackman and Mayor Thayne will coordinate. Council Member Bingham will donate the fill dirt and gravel.

10. Deweyville Fire Station Progress Report--Council Member Andersen discussed whether the station should have gas or electric heat. He suggests gas. There was a discussion of the different types of heaters. Keeping the building at 50 degrees is sufficient. Troy will wire for us but the town needs to purchase the supplies. Council Member Andersen needs to call Dominion and get an estimate on the gas heating costs. Council Member Kliger needs to get the doors installed. The overall cost so far is less than projected.
