Spend the day sewing together as we make the cheerful County Fair quilt pattern by A Quilting Life. This project is perfect for using up those extra mini charm packs and 2½" squares — whether you choose a scrappy look or a more planned layout, the result will be just as fun as a day at the fair!

To get the most out of this class, please be sure you've taken the basic rotary cutting class and feel confident with a consistent ¼" seam.

Pack a lunch so you can maximize your stitching time and enjoy a relaxed, creative day!

**Class Prep:**

- To maximize your class time, please pre-cut your jelly roll (or scraps) to 400 squares at 2 ½" and cut your background as shown on page 1 of the pattern. You will not need any of the border or binding fabric cut for class.

**Class Specific SUPPLY LIST:**

**NOTIONS:**

- Pattern: County Fair by A Quilting Life

**FABRIC:**

- 1 jelly roll or 2 yards assorted scraps
- 2 3/8 yards background fabric
- ½ yard inner border fabric (not needed for class)
- 5/8 yard binding (not needed for class)
- 3 ¾ yard backing (not needed for class)

**Cancellation Policy:**

If you need to cancel a class, our cancellation policy is as follows:

- 7+ days before class: Full Store Credit, 2-6 days before class: 50% Store Credit
- NO refunds will be given for "no shows" or cancellation made one day before class. Please note: teachers are not expected or required to offer make up classes.
- For ALL Retreats and Special Events, store credit will be given only if we can fill your spot and cancellation is more than 6 days prior to event. Many times, it is possible because we have a waiting list, but no promises.

We appreciate your support! Each student MUST have their own book or pattern. No Exceptions! As a courtesy to all, please no children, pets or guests in class and please watch the perfume. Many suffer allergies so please don't wear perfume when attending classes.

**Bring your BASIC SEWING SUPPLIES to class:**

- Sewing machine in working order with pedal and all cords
- ¼" foot for your machine
- Cotton piecing thread and bobbins already wound and ready to sew
- Scissors (large and small are generally useful in class)
- Thread snippers
- Seam ripper
- Rotary cutter and small cutting mat
- Quilt rulers (we suggest at least one ruler that is 6 ½" x 24 ½" and at least one additional ruler)
- Pin cushion and straight pins
- Small iron and pressing mat
- Fabric marking pens or pencils

**\*Don't forget to bring the specific supplies for your class!**
