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Class Prep:

Starch or pre-treat your fabrics, if desired, BEFORE cutting. Pre-cut and label your fabrics as shown on page 1 of the pattern.

Students should be comfortable with rotary cutting and have a good scant quarter inch seam to be most successful in this class.

Class Supply List:

- 3/8 yard darker blue
- 1 1/8 yard white with flowers or something of interest
- 1 yard medium blue
- 1 1/8 yard solid white
- You will need SIX different red fabrics. You will need 3/8 yard of four of the reds and 1/2 yard of two others.
- Binding is 1/2 yard and backing is 3.5 yards (neither of these are needed for class.)

Basic Supply List:

- Sewing machine in working order with pedal and all cords
- 1/4" foot for your machine
- Cotton piecing thread and bobbins already wound, ready to sew
- Scissors (large and small are generally useful in class)
- Thread snippers
- Seam ripper
- Rotary Cutter, mats are provided in class but a small one for yourself is okay
- Quilting rulers, if you get your pieces cut before class as recommended, you won't need any large rulers in class-you may want to bring a smaller ruler in case you need to trim something)
- Pin cushion and straight pins
- Small iron and pressing mat-a woolly clapper would be nice for opening our flying geese seams but it is not required
- Fabric marking pens or pencils
- TIP: A Stripology Squared or XL ruler will make cutting your project at home much quicker but it is not necessary for class.
