Description: Ready to take your binding skills to the next level? In Binding 201, we'll introduce two handy new tools that make folding and finishing your binding a breeze — no measuring or math required!

Janet will also demonstrate her favorite method for sewing binding down — no hand stitching involved! While this technique isn't intended for competition quilts, it's a quick and durable finish that's perfect for quilts meant to be loved and used every day.

Important Prerequisite:

You must have taken Lynn's Basic Binding class before enrolling in this class. We will not cover how to make or attach binding to your quilt. Bring a quilted lap-size or smaller project. You'll leave class with it completely bound and cuddle-ready!

Let's get binding!

Class Prep:

Please bring your quilted lap size or smaller project to class, ready to bind (quilted and trimmed).

Cut your binding strips (2 ¼" strips are preferred but you can do 2 ½") and sew end to end as taught in Basic Binding class.

Cancellation Policy:

Bring your BASIC SEWING SUPPLIES to class:

- Sewing machine in working order with pedal and all cords
- ¼" foot for your machine or Grid Glider if you have taken the Master Your ¼" Seam and More class with Janet
- Cotton piecing thread and bobbins already wound and ready to sew
- Scissors (large and small are generally useful in class)
- Thread snippers
- Seam ripper
- Rotary cutter and small cutting mat (for this class, we recommend a 4"x6" rotary mat-available at Cinnamon's)
- Quilt ruler-for this class a Creative Grids 2 ½" x 6 ½" ruler will be great
- Pin cushion and straight pins
- Small iron and pressing mat
- Frixxion marker-a color that will show up on your binding fabric
- CutRite Bind Up tool-this class is about teaching you to use this tool so it is required for class
- Third Hand Binding folder-again, this class is about teaching you to use this tool so it is required for class-choose your favorite size for binding, 2", 2 ½" or 2 ¾"
- Bottle of Elmer's White School Glue
