

Description: Get ready to shine with the Brightly Quilt! This cheerful pattern is perfect for newer sewists who are ready to take their skills up a notch. Using a Layer Cake or Fat Quarters, you'll create a quilt that's full of color and fun! You'll need a confident ¼" seam and some experience with rotary cutting or Stripology rulers — but don't worry, we'll guide you every step of the way. With just a few prints and a touch of background fabric, you'll be on your way to stitching up a beautiful, bright quilt that's sure to make you smile!

Class Prep:

- BEFORE CLASS: press, starch and precut all your fabric according to the directions on page 1 and 2 of your pattern. Don't forget to cut your background fabric!

Class Specific SUPPLY LIST:

NOTIONS:

- Pattern: Cluck Cluck Sew CCS #193

FABRIC:

- 42 pre-cut 10" squares OR 13 fat quarters
- 2.5 yards background fabric
- (Backing is 4 yards and binding is ½ yard but you don't need either for class)

Cancellation Policy:

If you need to cancel a class, our cancellation policy is as follows:

- 7+ days before class: Full Store Credit, 2-6 days before class: 50% Store Credit
- NO refunds will be given for "no shows" or cancellation made one day before class. Please note: teachers are not expected or required to offer make up classes.

Bring your BASIC SEWING SUPPLIES to class:

- Sewing machine in working order with pedal and all cords
- ¼" foot for your machine or Grid Glider if you have taken the Master Your ¼" Seam and More class with Janet
- Cotton piecing thread and bobbins already wound and ready to sew
- Scissors (large and small are generally useful in class)
- Thread snippers
- Seam ripper
- Pin cushion and straight pins
- Small iron and pressing mat
- Fabric marking pens or pencils
