FABRIC:

- One charm pack or forty 5" squares
- 1 yard coordinating fabric for slipper lining
- 10" x 13" Pellon fusible fleece
- ½ yard soft and stable
- 10" x 13" non slip sole fabric
- 505 glue stick
- Freezer paper

- Sewing machine in working order with pedal and all cords
- ¼" foot for your machine or Grid Glider if you have taken the Master Your ¼" Seam and More class with Janet
- Cotton piecing thread and bobbins already wound and ready to sew
- Scissors (large and small are generally useful in class)
- · Thread snippers
- Seam ripper
- Rotary cutter and small cutting mat
- Quilt rulers (we suggest at least one ruler that is 6 ½" x 24 ½" and at least one additional ruler)
- Pin cushion and straight pins
- Small iron and pressing mat
- · Fabric marking pens or pencils
