Class Prep:

Pre-class requirements will be covered in Pt.1 including fabric selections, how to trace pattern and select size, how to prep fabric before cutting (will not be cut in class nor do you need to have the fabric for Pt 1), construction marks. Need to be comfortable making a buttonhole. Bring paper and pen/pencil for notes. Bring Fiore Skirt pattern to class.

Class Specific Supply List:

- Woven fabric can be linen, denim, chambray, twill, poplin, cotton or lightweight canvas (yardage dependent upon size and length of skirt chosen and width of fabric, instructor will cover in class)
- Two buttons, 1/2" -3/4" (13mm-19mm) Or one button and one trouser hook
- Scrap of 1/4" twill tape or sturdy washable ribbon for inside closure (instructor has beige 1/4" twill tape)
- Buttonhole foot
- Leftover large fabric scraps
- Handsewing needles for button or button-sewing presser foot
- Optional: Seam Gauge
- Optional: Stitch in the ditch presser foot for top-stitching

Basic Sewing Supply List:

- Sewing Machine in good working order with foot pedal, power cords and feet
- Thread + Wound Bobbins
- Scissors (large + small)
- Thread Snips
- Pins + Pincushion
- Clips
- Marking Tools of choice
- Seam Ripper
- Notepaper and pencil/pen
