**Description:** Grab four fat quarters and join Janet for a fun and easy class where you'll create a set of beautiful, mix-and-match placemats! This beginner-friendly pattern is perfect for quilters of all levels and can be customized to fit any color scheme or décor style.

Whether you're freshening up your table for a new season or making a great handmade gift, these placemats come together quickly and creatively — no two sets are ever the same!

## Class Prep:

Before class: please starch, iron and pre-cut and LABEL your fabrics as shown on page 1. Each fat quarter is cut the exact same way. Using small snippets of your fabrics, make a color key with a snippet of each fabric and the numbers 1-4. This will be VERY helpful during class!

## Class Specific SUPPLY LIST:

### NOTIONS:

- Pattern: Fat Quarter Shuffle Mats PQD-269
- Pre-requisites for class: Rotary Cutting Tips and Tricks and Mastering the Scant  $\frac{1}{4}$ " Seam and More. Stripology 101 will be a great help for your at home cutting but is not required.

### FABRIC:

- Four fat quarters-non directional all over prints only
- Binding:  $\frac{5}{8}$  yard-not needed for class

### Cancellation Policy:

If you need to cancel a class, our cancellation policy is as follows:

- 7+ days before class: Full Store Credit, 2-6 days before class: 50% Store Credit
- NO refunds will be given for "no shows" or cancellation made one day before class. Please note: teachers are not expected or required to offer make up classes.
- For ALL Retreats and Special Events, store credit will be given only if we can fill your spot and cancellation is more than 6 days prior to event. Many times, it is possible because we have a waiting list, but no promises.

We appreciate your support! Each student MUST have their own book or pattern. No Exceptions! As a courtesy to all, please no children, pets or guests in class and please watch the perfume. Many suffer allergies so please don't wear perfume when attending classes.

### Bring your BASIC SEWING SUPPLIES to class:

- Sewing machine in working order with pedal and all cords
- $\frac{1}{4}$ " foot for your machine or Grid Glider (if you have taken the  $\frac{1}{4}$ " Seam and More class with Janet)
- Cotton piecing thread and bobbins already wound and ready to sew
- Scissors (large and small are generally useful in class)
- Thread snippers
- Seam ripper
- Rotary cutter and small cutting mat
- Quilt rulers (we suggest at least one ruler that is  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $24\frac{1}{2}$ " and at least one additional ruler)
- Pin cushion and straight pins
- Small iron and pressing mat

Fabric marking pens or pencils
