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Class Prep:

Cut your background fabric in $7\frac{3}{4}$ " squares (you will need at least four) and then cut them diagonally to make triangles.

Class Supply List:

- Class Kit (includes Scrappy Triangles 6" Pad and printed Perfect Piecing Paper)
- Add A Quarter Plus 12" Ruler
- Seam Roller
- Sewline Fabric Glue Pens
- This technique is a great scrap-buster! Bring a bucket of scraps (approximately 2 yards) you like OR bring 10-12 fat quarters of various prints.
- $\frac{1}{2}$ yard background (If you decide to make a whole quilt of these fun triangles, see the inside of the book for how much total background (and prints) you will need for the quilt size you want to make.

Basic Supply List:

- Sewing machine in working order with pedal and all cords
- Open or clear foot will be helpful
- Cotton piecing thread and bobbins already wound, ready to sew
- Scissors (large and small are generally useful in class)
- Thread snippers
- Seam ripper
- Rotary Cutter, mats are provided in class but a small one for yourself is okay
- Quilting rulers, we suggest $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $24\frac{1}{2}$ "
