**Description:** Ready to dive into real paper piecing? Join Janet as she guides you through the wonderful (and addictive!) world of Foundation Paper Piecing — a technique that allows for ultra-precise piecing and stunning designs. In this class, you'll learn all the basics, plus Janet's favorite tips, tricks, and must-have tools to make your paper piecing journey smooth and successful. Whether you've dabbled before or are brand new to the method, this class is the perfect place to build your confidence and sharpen your skills!

## **Class Prep:**

Before class, please make a copy on the Perfect Piecing Paper of at least five of the scrappy triangles in the pad so we can practice our technique! Definitely use the first and second and then pick a few from the book you like. Cut your background fabric in 7 ¾" squares (you will need at least four) and then cut them diagonally to make triangles.

#### **FABRIC:**

- This technique is a great scrap-buster! Bring a bucket of scraps (approximately 2 yards) you like OR bring 10-12 fat quarters of various prints.
- ½ yard background (If you decide to make a whole quilt of these fun triangles, see the inside of the book for how much total background (and prints) you will need for the quilt size you want to make.

# Bring your BASIC SEWING SUPPLIES to class:

- Sewing machine in working order with pedal and all cords
- ¼" foot for your machine or Grid Glider (if you have taken the ¼" Seam and More class with Janet)
- Cotton piecing thread and bobbins already wound and ready to sew
- Scissors (large and small are generally useful in class)
- · Thread snippers
- Seam ripper
- · Rotary cutter and small cutting mat
- Quilt rulers (we suggest at least one ruler that is 6 ½" x 24 ½" and at least one additional ruler)
- Pin cushion and straight pins
- Small iron and pressing mat

Fabric marking pens or pencils
