Description: Grab a jelly roll and a yard of border fabric — it's time to get stitching! This fun and fast quilt is a breeze to cut and piece, making it ideal for beginners or seasoned quilters looking for a quick, satisfying finish.

Class Prep:

Please iron, starch and pre-cut your jelly roll fabrics before class according to the directions on page 1. Janet will give you instructions in class for cutting the border fabric.

NOTIONS:

- Pre-requisites for class: Rotary Cutting Tips and Tricks, Master Your ¼" Seam and More.
- Pattern: Jelly Roll Patchwork

FABRIC:

- 1 Jelly Roll or forty strips of 2 ½" WOF strips
- 1 yard border fabric
- 2/3 yards binding fabric
- 3 ¾ yards backing fabric (you will not need binding or backing fabric in class and you won't need border fabric until the second class)

Cancellation Policy:

Bring your BASIC SEWING SUPPLIES to class:

- Sewing machine in working order with pedal and all cords
- ¼" foot for your machine or Grid Glider if you have taken the Master Your ¼" Seam and More class with Janet
- Cotton piecing thread and bobbins already wound and ready to sew
- Scissors (large and small are generally useful in class)
- Thread snippers
- Seam ripper
- Rotary cutter and small cutting mat
- Quilt rulers (we suggest at least one ruler that is 6 ½" x 24 ½" and at least one additional ruler)
- Pin cushion and straight pins
- Small iron and pressing mat
- · Fabric marking pens or pencils
