Description: Get ready for a fun and cheerful quilting experience with the Limone Cake pattern! This quilt begins with a Layer Cake (10" squares), which you can purchase pre-cut and coordinated, or cut yourself from your own fabric stash — the choice is yours! This pattern is not only enjoyable to make, but it also comes together quickly, making it perfect for quilters of all levels. Plus, if you've never tried a pieced border before, this is the perfect opportunity to learn. The Limone Cake quilt is a great introduction to adding that extra touch of design to your quilt edges. Let's get sewing and have some fun with color, creativity, and cake — Limone Cake!

Class Prep:

DO NOT starch your 10" pre-cut squares. DO iron and starch your accent fabric. Please pre-cut your fabrics as shown on page 2 of the pattern. Label (as described in the pattern) each of your cut fabrics for ease of assemble in class.

Class Specific SUPPLY LIST:

FABRIC:

- The class sample and fabric requirements given are for the lap sized quilt. If you are choosing another size quilt, please see fabric requirements on the back of the pattern.
- Thirty nine 10" assorted print squares
- ¾ yard accent fabric
- ½ yard binding and 3 ½ yard backing (not needed for class)

NOTIONS:

- Pre-requisites for class: Rotary Cutting Tips and Tricks and Master Your ¼" Seam and More
- Pattern: Limone Cake

Cancellation Policy:

If you need to cancel a class, our cancellation policy is as follows:

- 7+ days before class: Full Store Credit, 2-6 days before class: 50% Store Credit
- NO refunds will be given for "no shows" or cancellation made one day before class. Please note: teachers are not expected or required to offer make up classes.
- For ALL Retreats and Special Events, store credit will be given only if we can fill your spot and cancellation is more than 6 days prior to event. Many times, it is possible because we have a waiting list, but no promises.

Bring your BASIC SEWING SUPPLIES to class:

- Sewing machine in working order with pedal and all cords
- ¼" foot for your machine or Grid Glider if you have taken the Master Your ¼" Seam and More class with Janet
- Cotton piecing thread and bobbins already wound and ready to sew
- Scissors (large and small are generally useful in class)
- Thread snippers
- Seam ripper
- Rotary cutter and small cutting mat
- Quilt rulers (we suggest at least one ruler that is 6 ½" x 24 ½" and at least one additional ruler)
- Pin cushion and straight pins
- Small iron and pressing mat
- Fabric marking pens or pencils
