#### **NOTIONS:**

Pattern: Mini Brightly Holidays

#### **FABRIC:**

- Thirty nine pre-cut 5" squares or 8 fat eighths or scraps (chain fabrics)
- 3 fat eighths of orange fabrics for pumpkin patches
- 1 fat quarter or scrap or brown for pumpkin stems
- ¾ yard background fabric
- 1/3 yard binding and 1 ¼ yard backing (not needed for class)

### Cancellation Policy:

# Bring your BASIC SEWING SUPPLIES to class:

- Sewing machine in working order with pedal and all cords
- ¼" foot for your machine or Grid Glider if you have taken the Master Your ¼" Seam and More class with Janet
- Cotton piecing thread and bobbins already wound and ready to sew
- Scissors (large and small are generally useful in class)
- Thread snippers
- Seam ripper
- · Rotary cutter and small cutting mat
- Quilt rulers (we suggest at least one ruler that is 6 ½" x 24 ½" and at least one additional ruler)
- Pin cushion and straight pins
- Small iron and pressing mat
- · Fabric marking pens or pencils
