Please iron, starch and pre-cut all fabrics according to directions on page 246. It will be very helpful in class for you to have labeled each grouping by alphabet letter given. You will not need binding or backing fabrics for class. Pre-requisites for class: Rotary Cutting Tips and Tricks, Mastering the Scant 4" and More.

Class Specific SUPPLY LIST:

 Pattern: Trees with Stars Tabletopper from Prairie Home book

FABRIC:

- 13/4 yards background fabric
- 5 fat eighths of greens (for trees and star centers)
- 1 fat eighth brown for tree trunks
- 1/2 yard yellow/gold for stars
- 2 additional fat eighths yellow/gold for stars
- 9 fat quarters red prints for center square and border
- 5/8 yard binding (not needed for class)
- (if you wish to go scrappy, make sure you have a bit more of each color listed above)

- Sewing machine in working order with pedal and all cords
- ¼" foot for your machine or Grid Glider (if you have taken the ¼" Seam and More class with Janet)
- Cotton piecing thread and bobbins already wound and ready to sew
- Scissors (large and small are generally useful in class)
- Thread snippers
- Seam ripper
- · Rotary cutter and small cutting mat
- Quilt rulers (we suggest at least one ruler that is 6 ½" x 24 ½" and at least one additional ruler)
- Pin cushion and straight pins
- Small iron and pressing mat
- · Fabric marking pens or pencils
