With Lori Holt's clear, picture-filled instructions, we'll focus on creating the sunflower blooms and leaves during class. After that, you'll be all set to finish it up at home with confidence! Dig into your fabric stash or treat yourself to some fresh prints — either way, you're in for a fun and creative sewing session!

## Class Prep:

Please iron, starch and pre-cut all fabrics according to directions on page 98. You will not need binding or backing fabrics for class.

## Class Specific SUPPLY LIST:

### NOTIONS:

- Pre-requisites for class: Rotary Cutting Tips and Tricks, Master Your ¼" Seam and More.
- Pattern: Prairie Home book by Lori Holt, page 98, "Prairie Sunflower Tabletopper."

### FABRIC:

- 1 1/8 yards background fabric
- 3/8 yard yellow print for flowers
- Fat eighth light brown print-flower centers
- Fat eighth or 10" square dark brown print-flower centers
- 4 fat quarters green prints for leaves
- 9 fat quarters blue prints for center 9-patch and middle border
- (if you wish to go scrappy, make sure you have a bit more of each color listed above)

### Bring your BASIC SEWING SUPPLIES to class:

- Sewing machine in working order with pedal and all cords
- ¼" foot for your machine or Grid Glider if you have taken the Master Your ¼" Seam and More class with Janet
- Cotton piecing thread and bobbins already wound and ready to sew
- Scissors (large and small are generally useful in class)
- Thread snippers
- Seam ripper
- Rotary cutter and small cutting mat
- Quilt rulers (we suggest at least one ruler that is 6 ½" x 24 ½" and at least one additional ruler)
- Pin cushion and straight pins
- Small iron and pressing mat
- Fabric marking pens or pencils

### Cancellation Policy:

If you need to cancel a class, our cancellation policy is as follows:

- 7+ days before class: Full Store Credit, 2-6 days before class: 50% Store Credit
- NO refunds will be given for "no shows" or cancellation made one day before class. Please note: teachers are not expected or required to offer make up classes.
