**Description:** Join Janet and Robyn throughout 2026 as we stitch our way through six quilts from the Scrap Happy Quilts book by Annie's Quilting. Each month, we'll gather for two consecutive days — no need to pack up your machine between sessions! Together, we'll dive into a different quilt from the book and sew it step by step in a fun, supportive, scrap-busting environment.

## Class Prep:

- It is highly recommended that you have taken the basic rotary cutting class AND ¼" seam class. These skills will not be covered in class. If you have taken stripology, you may find those skills useful in cutting your class kit.

### FABRIC:

- See monthly schedule above for fabric requirements for each month. You can make your quilt in the style of fabrics in the pattern or do something completely different! One of the joys of using this book is that it is designed for scraps so use the opportunity to dig out your scrap bin!
- Please come pre-cut for each session to make best use of your class time. You can cut in class but you will get lots more sewing finished if you come already cut.

### Cancellation Policy:

If you need to cancel a class, our cancellation policy is as follows:

- 7+ days before class: Full Store Credit, 2-6 days before class: 50% Store Credit
- NO refunds will be given for "no shows" or cancellation made one day before class. Please note: teachers are not expected or required to offer make up classes.
- For ALL Retreats and Special Events, store credit will be given only if we can fill your spot and cancellation is more than 6 days prior to event. Many times, it is possible because we have a waiting list, but no promises.

We appreciate your support! Each student MUST have their own book or pattern. No Exceptions! As a courtesy to all, please no children, pets or guests in class and please watch the perfume. Many suffer allergies so please don't wear perfume when attending classes.

### Bring your BASIC SEWING SUPPLIES to class:

- Sewing machine w/ cord & foot pedal
- sewing machine manual
- sewing machine needles and wound bobbins
- rotary cutter and small mat to cut at your seat
- 100% cotton thread (we love Aurifil!)
- craft iron and small ironing mat
- Snips and fabric scissors
- seam ripper
- Quilting rulers (we recommend 6 1/2" x 12 1/2" and 6 1/2" x 24 1/2")
- straight pins and pin cushion
- fabric marking pen or pencil
- post-it notes and pen/pencil
