Description: Get ready to elevate your quilting skills with the Sunrise Star — a stunning, scrappy quilt that's also fat quarter friendly!

In this class, you'll learn a fun and efficient method for creating flying geese and half-square triangles, designed to sharpen your techniques and build your confidence. Perfect for advanced beginners to intermediate sewists, this project offers just the right mix of challenge and creativity. Come join us and stitch your way to a beautiful quilt top you'll be proud to show off!

Class Prep:

Pre-requisites for class: Rotary Cutting Tips and Tricks, Master Your ¼" Seam and More and Stripology 101 will definitely speed along your at-home cutting!

Before class please iron, starch and cut all fabrics as shown on page 1 and 2. For fat quarters, you will cut each FQ as shown on page 1 and then cut your background fabric as shown on page 2. If you are using yardage so all blocks are the same, cutting directions are all on page 2. Label all your pieces for ease of sewing in class.

Class Specific SUPPLY LIST:

NOTIONS:

- Sunrise Star Quilt pattern by Nomadic Quilter
- Highly recommended: Mini Stripology Squared and Mini Stripology Quarters rulers

FABRIC:

- The class sample and fabric requirements given are for the throw sized quilt. If you choose to make a different size, please see the back of the pattern for fabric requirements.
- 20 fat quarters for scrappy version OR see requirements for Fabrics A-D to make all blocks the same
- 2 7/8 yards background fabric
- ½ yard Binding fabric and 3 5/8 yards backing fabric (not needed for class)

Cancellation Policy:

If you need to cancel a class, our cancellation policy is as follows:

- 7+ days before class: Full Store Credit, 2-6 days before class: 50% Store Credit
- NO refunds will be given for "no shows" or cancellation made one day before class. Please note: teachers are not expected or required to offer make up classes.
- For ALL Retreats and Special Events, store credit will be given only if we can fill your spot and cancellation is more than 6 days prior to event. Many times, it is possible because we have a waiting list, but no promises.

We appreciate your support! Each student **MUST** have their own book or pattern. No Exceptions! As a courtesy to all, please no children, pets or guests in class and please watch the perfume. Many suffer allergies so please don't wear perfume when attending classes.

Bring your BASIC SEWING SUPPLIES to class:

- Sewing machine in working order with pedal and all cords
- ¼" foot for your machine or Grid Glider if you have taken the Master Your ¼" Seam and More class with Janet
- Cotton piecing thread and bobbins already wound and ready to sew
- Scissors (large and small are generally useful in class)
- Thread snippers
- Seam ripper
- Rotary cutter and small cutting mat
- Quilt rulers (we suggest at least one ruler that is 6 ½" x 24 ½" and at least one additional ruler)
- Pin cushion and straight pins
- Small iron and pressing mat
- Fabric marking pens or pencils
