Supplies to bring to class:

Fabric:

Bambi panel (in class purchase payable to instructor)

(7) 7" x 7" squares of muslin for samples

Fat Quarters in your chosen color way for stems, leaves, butterfly, flowers and buds

Notions:

5" Morgan embroidery hoop

Sewline Fabric Mechanical Pencil Trio (includes roller ball, black and white ceramic pencils)

Loew Cornell transfer paper

4" embroidery scissors

Needle threader (this saves lots of time in class!)

Circle Template, available at office supply stores

1" x 6" ruler

Sandpaper board

Small wooden press

Bamboo point turner

Three 3" x 3" squares of crinoline

Needles:

#10 Betweens needles

#10 Sharps needles

#22 and #24 Chenille needles

Threads:

Perle Cotton 5 in colors(s) of choice to practice stitches

Neutral cotton thread visible on above fat quarters

#100 Silk or #80 wt. cotton to match above fat quarters for appliqué

#50 wt. cotton threads in colors to match flower fabrics

Continue for Pre-Class Work

PRIOR TO CLASS:

Cut and label each of the following from the above fat quarters:

One 1" x 6" bias strip for **stem**

Two 2" x 3" rectangles for **leaves**, one light/medium, one medium/dark

Circles: one each:

2-1/2" for **bud**

1-3/4" for **calyx**

For flowers:

Three circles each:

3" for flower

2" for calyx

One 3" x 3" square

One 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" strip (fold in half lengthwise, wrong sides together and stitch with a 1/4" seam allowance)

One 1-1/2" x 8-1/3"

One 1" x 3-1/2" rectangle for flower center

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
