

Proper Use and Hygiene with Homemade Face Coverings

- Before putting on a mask, wash hands.
- Cover mouth and nose with mask and tie around head.
- Avoid touching the mask while using it; if you do, wash your hands.
- Replace the mask with a new one if it becomes damp.
- To remove the mask: remove it from behind (do not touch the front of mask); place directly in washing machine or plastic bag until it can be placed in the washing machine
- The mask can be hand washed or washed in the washing machine and dried in the dryer or in direct sunlight
- The mask should be washed between each use

A face covering may help prevent spread of the virus, but should be used with appropriate social distancing and hand washing.



Masks are effective only when used in combination with frequent hand-washing.

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
