Supplies to bring to class:

The first class we will work on the baskets and leaves. The remaining five classes will focus on the details of each of the five blocks in the quilt.

A sewing machine and quarter inch foot will be needed in the first class only. (A working knowledge of your machine is required.)

Pattern:

My Favorite Flowers pattern by Graham Cracker Collection

Fabrics:

The fabrics for the quilt are listed on the back of the pattern. For the first class, you will only need the following fabrics:

One 9-1/2" x 9-1/2" for background square

One 3" x 12" strip for basket

Two 3" x 9" strips for leaves

Threads:

Sewing machine thread to match basket fabric

Basting thread in a color that will be visible on the basket fabric and leaf fabric

#100 Silk or #80 cotton thread to match basket and leave fabrics

Three skeins Perle Cotton 12 for the handle in your desired colors. I chose:

- One green (base handle)
- One brown (handle accent)
- One red (berries)

Notions:

Sulky Tender Touch Stabilizer if using silk for baskets or appliqué

Loew Cornell Transfer paper

Sewline Marking Pencil, which includes a tracer and one black and one white lead

Fiskars 8" rotating cutting mat

Small rotary cutter

Fan Favorite Template by Graham Cracker Collection

Small wooden pressor

Bamboo needle turner

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
