Supplies to bring to class:

Book: *Christmas Figs* by Joanna Figueroa

Fabrics:

At least 1/3 yard of eight different fabrics for your pinwheels
At least 2 yards of background to get started.

If you want to make your quilt the size shown in the book, you will need:

4 yards background (can be the same or different prints that total 4 yards)

2/3 yard of four different reds (or other color you choose)

2/3 yard of four different greens (or other color you choose)

5/8 yard binding fabric

7/8 yard borders (can be the same as background)

All other size projects can be figured in class if you want to do a bed runner, table runner, small lap size, etc.

Notions:

Sewing machine in good working order (cleaned and oiled recently)

Sewing machine manuals

Extra bobbin and needles for machine

Foot pedal and cord for sewing machine

Cake Mix 3 (you will need two of these if you want to make the quilt size in the book)

Fabric scissors

Pencil

Pincushion and pins

Seam ripper

Rotary rulers, rotary cutter and cutting board (I highly recommend at least one ruler that is 2 1/2 inches wide-either a 6 1/2" long or 12 1/2" long. It's much easier to work with for small cutting projects. I always recommend Olfa rotary cutters and Creative Grids rulers!)

Clearly Perfect Angles tool for precision 1/4" seams and amazing triangle flips. (If you do not have your Clearly Perfect Angles tool installed before class and wish to use it in class, please come 30 minutes early and I will get it installed for you before class.) If you are not using Clearly Perfect Angles, you will need a Frixion pen and a small ruler.

****BEFORE CLASS**:** Please cut 10" squares from your red and green fabrics and cut at least FOUR 10" squares of your background fabric.

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
