### **Supplies to bring to class:**

Sewing machine, pedal, cords, feet AND the tray for your sewing machine if you have one

Thread and full bobbins (neutral to coordinate with your fabric works great)

Scissors or snips and Seam ripper

Clearly Perfect Angles tool if you are still looking for a good  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam

Rotary cutter and rulers-if you have trouble with the  $\frac{7}{8}$ " mark, Creative Grids has a great  $\frac{7}{8}$ " ruler which you will love!

Frixion pen (or other removeable ink/chalk marker) and small ruler for drawing lines on fabric-you want to make sure you can draw very thin lines!

Optional: ironing mat and iron and Fons & Porter's Quarter inch Seam Markers (love this for marking half triangle squares!)

**Book:** Miss Rosie's Farmhouse Favorites

### **Fabric required:**

14 assorted light fat quarters for blocks and inner border

19 assorted medium and dark prints for blocks and outer border

$\frac{3}{4}$  yard for binding

4  $\frac{3}{4}$  yard for backing

### **HOMEWORK BEFORE FIRST CLASS:**

From your lights cut a total of 112 (one hundred twelve)  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares

From your darks cut a total of 112 (one hundred twelve)  $2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares

From your lights cut 18 (eighteen) squares at  $5\frac{1}{4}$ "

From your darks cut 18 (eighteen) squares at  $5\frac{1}{4}$ "

Optional: If you want to draw your lines on the squares before class, feel free. You can either draw one line diagonally on each square or one line  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the center on each side of the triangles. You won't need to mark 48 of the dark squares. We have a great new tool from Fons and Porter called a Quarter inch seam marker that is really helpful with this task. I will demo it in class.

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
