Supplies to bring to class:

Sewing machine in working order with all cords and pedals

Cotton piecing thread and bobbins already wound and ready to sew

Scissors (large and small are generally useful in class)

Thread snippers

Seam ripper

Rotary cutter and rulers (we suggest Creative Grids, at least one ruler that is 6 ½" x 24 ½" and at least one additional ruler)

Pin cushion and pins

Small iron and ironing mat or wooly mat

Small rotary cutter mat so you can cut at your seat

Fabric marking pens or pencils

Recommended but not required:

Clearly Perfect Angles (helps with a great ¼" seam and you don't have to draw so many lines and also helps with mitering corners)

Perkins Perfect Seam guide-to regularly check that ¼" seam!

Can of Faultless Professional Starch-available at most Target stores, Publix and Walmart. DON'T purchase on Amazon-way too expensive!
