Supplies to bring to class: **FOR CLASS 1 ONLY:**

For making the Stitch Sampler Book:

Cut the following pieces using a pinking blade in your rotary cutter:

- 13" x 44" piece of fabric
- 13" x 44" piece of batting

For page dividers and book embellishment:

- Ten - 14" long fibers, such as tiny rick rack, novelty yarns, cording, narrow trims, etc.
- Two - 45" long fibers, such as tiny rick rack, novelty yarns, cording, narrow trims, etc.

Book Closure:

- 1 yard ribbon
- 1 button

Page Labels:

- 1/2" wide double stitch tape
- 3 yards of 13mm silk ribbon*
- 1/4 yard 5/8" cotton twill tape*

(*A selection of ribbon will be available in class for sale from Jan.)

Notions:

- Sewing machine in good working order and working knowledge of machine
- A new #75 needle in machine
- Applique foot for sewing machine
- Marking pencil
- 6-1/2" x 24" ruler



- Neutral thread for sewing machine
- Kwik Klip Safety Pin Tool (invaluable tool for using with safety pins!)
- 44 safety pins
- Teflon pressing sheet
- Misty Fuse
- Parchment paper

FOR CLASSES 2 through 5:

- Mary Thomas's Dictionary of Embroidery Stitches
- A variety of threads for embroidery stitches: Perle cottons, floss, wool, metallic threads, etc.
- Variety pack of needles: embroidery, tapestry, chenille, milliners, sharps
