Supplies to bring to class:

Pattern: Tossed Nine Patch by Eleanor Burns

Fabric requirements:

3 Charm packs (or a layer cake cut into quarters or 96 - 5 inch squares. Charms are the quickest and easiest way to go:). The charms need to be identical packs*.

Cornerstones - $\frac{1}{4}$ yard

First border: $\frac{1}{2}$ yard

Second border: 1 and $\frac{1}{8}$ yards

Binding: $\frac{2}{3}$ yards

Back: $3\frac{1}{2}$ yards

Quilt finishes at 56 by 72 inches

Accent: $\frac{1}{3}$ yard (pattern calls for light - those are my small red squares throughout)

Sewing machine that you are very familiar with so you will be able to wind bobbins, thread, etc.

***** $\frac{1}{4}$ inch foot or patchwork foot REQUIRED*****

Pins

Scissors

Rotary cutter with a new or sharp blade

Neutral thread

Seam Ripper, just in case

$6\frac{1}{2}$ inch by 24 inch ruler

Cutting mat Sewing notions that you enjoy using:)

Pencil and scrap paper for labeling pieces
