## Fabric:

24 by 42-inch piece of batting
Backing: 24 by 42 inches
8 background fat quarters
Binding: 1/2 yard
Green fat quarter for stems and WELCOME FRIENDS words
Black fat quarter
2 red fat quarters
1 black print fat quarter
Black scraps with a small scale print for flower centers
12 inch by $61 / 2$ inch small print on black for basket
Scrap of orange for crow's beak
Red scrap with small scale print for star on basket
Black button for star
Small black bead for crow eye
Multiple $61 / 2$ inch scraps of several colors for $1 / 2$ square triangles (and you can use leftovers from background fabric NOTE:***** scraps for using $1 / 2$ square triangles MUST be $61 / 2$ inches square ${ }^{* * * * * * * * . ~(Y o u ~ w i l l ~ n e e d ~}$ 12 lights and darks that are $61 / 2$ inches square - minimum). I used several and had leftovers for another project:)

## Notions:

Spinning Stars provided in class
APPLIQUÉ FOOT
QUARTER INCH FOOT
Matching thread for each appliqué piece color
Neutral thread for piecing
Scissors
Pins
Heat $n$ bond light ( $1 / 2$ yard)
Rotary cutter and mat (small will work)
Pencil
You may want to bring your own iron, but not necessary KNOW HOW TO REDUCE YOUR STITCH LENGTH! Very important**** Sewing machine in good working order with knowledge of threading bobbins, needles and stitch length.

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
