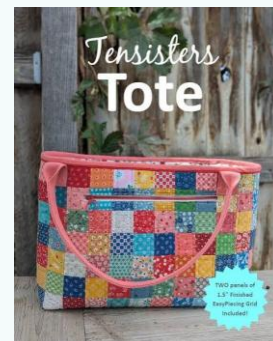

- Iron your squares onto your panels in your desired layout
