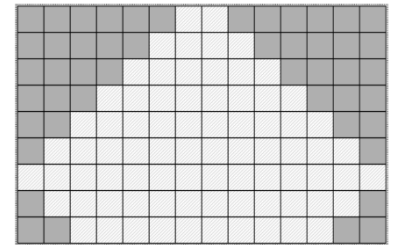


Before You Come to Class

- Cut out all your fabric squares –

The pattern has you assemble a full rectangle of 108 squares to prep to cut your hat cone piece. Some of these squares will be discarded when you cut out your template. I have calculated that you will have approximately 70 squares that will actually show in your finished hat cone.

- Place your patchwork squares as desired on your Easy Piecing Grid panel. The diagram to the right shows the squares in white that will most likely be in the area you will cut for your hat cone template.

Please bring your panel to the first class with your squares ironed in place and ready to sew.

Class Session 1

- Sew your patchwork grid panel I show you techniques for the panel to give you perfect results.
- Trace your witch hat top piece template on to your patchwork panel where desired to prepare for machine quilting.
- Layer your finished patchwork right side up on your soft and stable foam stabilizer and attach using basting spray to hold in place.
- Using basting spray adhere your hat lining fabric to the other side of the soft and stable foam stabilizer.

- Baste all the layers together on your sewing machine by stitching along your traced template line.
- Machine quilt your patchwork hat top piece – I will suggest options and this step is where a walking foot does come in handy if you happen to have one.
- Trace the template for your hat brim on your brim lining fabric and attach to one side of your heavyweight stabilizer
- Cut out and prepare your binding strips for final assembly if we have time.

Class Session 2

- Cut out hat top piece after quilting is complete.
- Attach your Brim top fabric to the other side or add optional Soft and stable layer first if desired.
- Baste all layers together on the traced lines of your template and machine quilt if desired.
- Hat assembly steps – we hope to send you home with your finished hat to wear or display.
