



French Lemoyne Christmas Quilt

52" x 66"

Supplies Needed:

- 2 ¼ yards cream background fabric
- ¼ yard of nine different star colors
- 1 yard sashing
- 2 yards border fabric
- ½ yard for binding
- 3 ⅓ yard for backing
- **Rapid Fire Lemoyne Star Ruler**

Cutting:

From the Nine Star Colors Cut the Following:

- A total of (12) 3 ¼" x width of fabric strips

From the Cream Background Fabric Cut the Following:

- (12) 4 ¾" x width of fabric strips

From the Cream/Green Sashing Fabric Cut the Following:

- (8) 12 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles
- (5) 2 ½" x 40 ½" strips for horizontal sashing rows
- (3) 2 ½" x width of fabric strips for inner side borders

From the Red Border Fabric Cut or Rip the Following:

- (4) strips 4 ½" x Length of Fabric

Lemoyne Stars:

1. Refer to the Rapid Fire Lemoyne Star Ruler Directions and make (12) 12" finished stars.

Assembly:

2. Using three 12 ½" x 2 ½" sashing rectangles and three blocks, construct a row as shown. Press towards the sashing strips. Make four rows.
3. Using five 2 ½" x 40 ½" strips and four rows, assemble the quilt center as shown. Press towards the sashing strips.
4. Determine the length of the quilt by measuring from top to bottom in three places and taking the average. Using your three remaining 2 ½" sashing strips, construct two inner border strips that match the length of the quilt. Sew them to the two sides and press out towards the sashing strips.
5. Repeat step four to add the side outer borders first, and then the top and bottom borders. Press towards the borders.
